Now that is the revelation: Jesus Christ is God. The Jehovah of the Old Testament is the Jesus of the New. No matter how hard you try, you can't prove there are THREE Gods. But it also takes a revelation by the Holy Spirit to make you understand the truth that He is One. It takes a revelation to see that the Jehovah of the Old Testament is the Jesus of the New. Satan crept into the church and blinded the people to this truth. And when they were blinded to it, it wasn't long until the Church of Rome stopped baptizing in the Name of the Lord Jesus Christ.

JOHN 19:19» 19 † ¶ And Pilate wrote a title, and put it on the cross. And the writing was, **JESUS OF NAZARETH THE KING OF THE JEWS.**

JOHN 19:20» 20 [†] This title then read many of the Jews: for the place where Jesus was crucified was night o the city: and it was written in **Hebrew, and Greek, and Latin**.

The four Canaanite-Hebrew letters *Yodh, Heh, Waw, Heh* are correctly transliterated in Roman (Latin) letters as YHWH and erroneously transliterated as JHVH. The erroneous four letter Romanized (Latinized) version, JHVH was rendered as "JEHOVAH".

When Yeshua (Jesus) died on the cross, Pilate had the words "Jesus of Nazareth, King of the Jews." I believe in Hebrew that would read Yeshua Ha'Netzeret V'mlech Ha'Yehudim. Yeshua is Jesus (Gk), Ha'Netzeret is "of Nazareth, V'mlech is "the King" and Yehudim is from Yehuda or of Judah, the tribe from which Yeshua descended. By taking the first letters of each of these four words we get **Y-H-V-H, or YHVH**, the tetragrammaton of Y_hw_h or Y_hv_H (Yahweh).

The **tetragrammaton** (from <u>Greek</u> τετραγράμματον, meaning "four letters")[1][2] is the Hebrew <u>theonym</u>, commonly <u>transliterated</u> into Latin letters as **YHWH**. It is one of the <u>names of the God of Israel</u> used in the <u>Hebrew Bible</u>.

While YHWH is the most common transliteration of the tetragrammaton in English academic studies, the alternatives YHVH, JHVH and JHWH are also used.[3][4]

Although <u>Yahweh</u> is favored by most Hebrew scholars and is widely accepted as the vocalization of the Tetragrammaton, <u>Jehovah</u> is still used in some translations of the Bible. The <u>Samaritans</u> understood the pronunciation to be <u>iabe</u>. Some <u>patristic</u> sources give evidence for a Greek pronunciation <u>iaō</u>.[5]

As religiously observant <u>Jews</u> are forbidden to say or write the Tetragrammaton in full, when reading the Torah they use the word <u>Adonai</u>.[5] And although most Christians have no prohibition on vocalizing the Tetragrammaton, in most Christian translations of the Bible, "LORD" is used in place of the Tetragrammaton, after the Hebrew <u>Adonai</u>, and is often written with <u>small capitals</u> (or in all caps) to distinguish it from other words translated as "Lord".

The name may be derived from a verb that means "to be, to exist".[1]



Council of Churches

In more modern times John R. Mott organized the **1910** International Missionary Conference, held in Edinburgh. Well attended, this conference fostered **other movements**. **Out of it sprang the International Missionary Council in 1921**. Bishop Charles Brent of the United States returned from Edinburgh fired up to create **the World Conference of Faith and Order which was finally brought into being in 1927 at Lausanne**. **Brent wanted to confront doctrinal issues head on**. With a vision of Christendom united for rebuilding the world that had been ravaged by World War I, **Archbishop** Nathan Söderblom of Uppsala spearheaded a drive to bring Christians to **Stockholm in 1925 for a Life and Work conference**.

The World Conference of Faith and Order proposed creating a World Council of Churches. A 1937 meeting of Life and Faith agreed to explore joining this movement. At Utrecht in 1938 the two movements united and set up a preliminary headquarters in Geneva. Roman Catholics and Russian Orthodox refused involvement, the Russians saying, "Orthodox Christians must regard the Holy Orthodox Catholic Church as the true Church of Christ, one and unique." For the Orthodox or Catholics it seemed that to join was equivalent to saying that all "churches" are equal. Some regional Orthodox, however, did send delegates and observers to these various meetings. The World Council of Churches planned to hold its first conference shortly, but World War II intervened.

Not until this day, <u>August 22, 1948</u> was the plan fulfilled. Then the World Council of Churches was born in Amsterdam.

airstyles of the 1920s created more controversy in hair fashion than in any other period of American culture. And one hairstyle, known simply as "the bob," would be at the center of this great debate. First introduced during the Great War, the bob haircut would eventually cause a revolution in the way women would wear their hair forevermore.

Ι

t all started in **1915** with the debut of the Castle Bob, named after the celebrated ballroom dancer Irene Castle. While cutting her hair for convenience, little would she know that she would forever be associated with triggering a revolution in 20th-century hair fashion. The Castle Bob would be the first indication of things to come ¾ the rage of short hair.

In the 1920s, a new woman was born. She smoked, drank, danced, and voted. She cut her hair, wore make-up, and went to petting parties. She was giddy and took risks. She was a flapper.

The "Younger Generation"

Before the start of <u>World War I</u>, the Gibson Girl was the rage. Inspired by <u>Charles Dana Gibson's</u> <u>drawings</u>, the Gibson Girl wore her long hair loosely on top of her head and wore a long straight skirt and a shirt with a high collar. She was feminine but also broke through several gender barriers for her attire allowed her to participate in sports, including golf, roller skating, and bicycling.

Then World War I started. The young men of the world were being used as cannon fodder for an older generation's ideals and mistakes. The attrition rate in the trenches left few with the hope that they would survive long enough to return home. They found themselves inflicted with an "eat-drink-and-be-merry-for-tomorrow-we-die spirit." Far away from the society that raised them and faced with the reality of death, many searched (and found) extreme life experiences before they entered the battlefield.

When the war was over, the survivors went home and the world tried to return to normalcy. Unfortunately, settling down in peacetime proved more difficult than expected. During the war, the boys had fought against both the enemy and death in far away lands; the girls had bought into the patriotic fervor and aggressively entered the workforce. During the war, both the boys and the girls of this generation had broken out of society's structure; they found it very difficult to return.

They found themselves expected to settle down into the humdrum routine of American life as if nothing had happened, to accept the moral dicta of elders who seemed to them still to be living in a Pollyanna land of rosy ideals which the war had killed for them. They couldn't do it, and they very disrespectfully said so.²

Women were just as anxious as the men to avoid returning to society's rules and roles after the war. In the age of the Gibson Girl, young women did not date, they waited until a proper young man formally paid her interest with suitable intentions (i.e. marriage). However, nearly a whole generation of young men had died in the war, leaving nearly a whole generation of young women without possible suitors. Young women decided that they were not willing to waste away their young lives waiting idly for spinsterhood; they were going to enjoy life.

The "Younger Generation" was breaking away from the old set of values.

The "Flapper"

The term "flapper" first appeared in Great Britain after World War I. It was there used to describe young girls, still somewhat awkward in movement who had not yet entered womanhood. In the June 1922 edition of the *Atlantic Monthly*, G. Stanley Hall described looking in a dictionary to discover what the evasive term "flapper" meant:

[T]he dictionary set me right by defining the word as a fledgling, yet in the nest, and vainly attempting to fly while its wings have only pinfeathers; and I recognized that the genius of 'slanguage' had made the squab the symbol of budding girlhood.³

Authors such <u>F. Scott Fitzgerald</u> and artists such as <u>John Held Jr.</u> first used the term to the U.S., half reflecting and half creating the image and style of the flapper. Fitzgerald described the ideal flapper as "lovely, expensive, and about nineteen." Held accentuated the flapper image by drawing young girls wearing unbuckled galoshes that would make a "flapping" noise when walking. ⁵

Many have tried to define flappers. In William and Mary Morris' Dictionary of Word and Phrase Origins, they state, "In America, a flapper has always been a giddy, attractive and slightly unconventional young thing who, in [H. L.] Mencken's words, 'was a somewhat foolish girl, full of wild surmises and inclined to revolt against the precepts and admonitions of her elders." Flappers had both an image and an attitude.

Flapper Image

The Flappers' image consisted of drastic - to some, shocking - changes in women's clothing and hair. Nearly every article of clothing was trimmed down and lightened in order to make movement easier.

It is said that girls "parked" their <u>corsets</u> when they were to go dancing.⁷ The new, energetic dances of the Jazz Age, required women to be able to move freely, something the "ironsides" didn't allow. Replacing the pantaloons and corsets were underwear called "step-ins."

The outer clothing of flappers is even still extremely identifiable. This look, called "garconne" ("little boy"), was instigated by Coco Chanel. To look more like a boy, women tightly wound their chest with strips of cloth in order to flatten it. The waists of flapper clothes were dropped to the hipline. She wore stockings - made of rayon ("artificial silk") starting in 1923 - which the flapper often wore rolled over a garter belt. The waists of the strips of

The hem of the skirts also started to rise in the 1920s. At first the hem only rose a few inches, but from 1925 to 1927 a flapper's skirt fell just below the knee.

The skirt comes just an inch below her knees, overlapping by a faint fraction her rolled and twisted stockings. The idea is that when she walks in a bit of a breeze, you shall now and then observe the knee (which is *not* rouged - that's just newspaper talk) but always in an accidental, Venus-surprised-at-the-bath sort of way.¹¹

The Gibson Girl, who prided herself on her long, beautiful, lush hair, was shocked when the flapper cut her's off. The short haircut was called the "bob" which was later replaced by an even shorter haircut, the "shingle" or "Eton" cut. The shingle cut was slicked down and had a curl on each side of the face that covered the woman's ears. Flappers often finished the ensemble with a felt, bell-shaped hat called a cloche.

Flappers also started wearing make-up, something that had previously been only worn by loose women. Rouge, powder, eye-liner, and lipstick became extremely popular.

Beauty is the fashion in 1925. She is frankly, heavily made up, not to imitate nature, but for an altogether artificial effect - pallor mortis, poisonously scarlet lips, richly ringed eyes - the latter looking not so much debauched (which is the intention) as diabetic.¹²

Flapper Attitude

The flapper attitude was characterized by stark truthfulness, fast living, and sexual behavior. Flappers seemed to cling to youth as if it were to leave them at any moment. They took risks and were reckless.

They wanted to be different, to announce their departure from the Gibson Girl's morals. So they smoked. Something only men had done previously. Their parents were shocked.

I was sure my girls had never experimented with a hip-pocket flask, flirted with other women's husbands, or smoked cigarettes. My wife entertained the same smug delusion, and was saying something like that out loud at the dinner table one day. And then she began to talk about other girls.

"They tell me that that Purvis girl has cigarette parties at her home," remarked my wife.

She was saying it for the benefit of Elizabeth, who runs somewhat with the Purvis girl. Elizabeth was regarding her mother with curious eyes. She made no reply to her mother, but turning to me, right there at the table, she said: "Dad, let's see your cigarettes."

Without the slightest suspicion of what was forthcoming, I threw Elizabeth my cigarettes. She withdrew a fag from the package, tapped it on the back of her left hand, inserted it between her lips, reached over and took my lighted cigarette from my mouth, lit her own cigarette and blew airy rings toward the ceiling.

My wife nearly fell out of her chair, and I might have fallen out of mine if I hadn't been momentarily stunned.¹³

Smoking wasn't the most outrageous of the flapper's rebellious actions. Flappers drank alcohol. At a time when the United States had outlawed alcohol (<u>Prohibition</u>), young women were starting the habit early. Some even carried hip-flasks full so as to have it on hand. More than a few adults didn't like to see tipsy young women. Flappers had a scandalous image as the "giddy flapper, rouged and clipped, careening in a drunken stupor to the lewd strains of a jazz quartet."¹⁴

The 1920s was the Jazz Age and one of the most popular past-times for flappers was dancing. Dances such as the <u>Charleston</u>, <u>Black Bottom</u>, and the <u>Shimmy</u> were considered "wild" by older generations. As described in the May 1920 edition of the *Atlantic Monthly*, flappers "trot like foxes, limp like lame ducks, one-step like cripples, and all to the barbaric yawp of strange instruments which transform the whole scene into a moving-picture of a fancy ball in bedlam." For the Younger Generation, the dances fit their fast-paced life-style.

For the first time since the train and the bicycle, a new form of faster transportation was becoming popular. Henry Ford's innovations were making the automobile an accessible commodity to the people. Cars were fast and risky - perfect for the flapper attitude. Flappers not only insisted on riding in them; they drove them.

Unfortunately for their parents, flappers didn't just use cars to ride in. The back seat became a popular location for the new popular sexual activity, petting. Others hosted petting parties. Though their attire was modeled after little boys' outfits, flappers flaunted their sexuality. It was a radical change from their parents and grandparents' generations.

Though many were shocked by the flapper's skimpy attire and licentious behavior, a less extreme version of the flapper became respectable among the old and the young. Some women cut off their hair and stopped wearing their corsets, but didn't go to the extreme of flapperhood.

At the end of the 1920s, the <u>stock market crashed</u> and the world was plunged into the <u>Great Depression</u>. Frivolity and recklessness was forced to come to an end. However, much of the flapper's changes remained.

In the 1920s, flappers broke away from the Victorian image of womanhood. They dropped the corset, chopped their hair, dropped layers of clothing to increase ease of movement, wore make-up, created the

concept of dating, and became a sexual person. They created what many consider the "new" or "modern" woman.

When She Cuts Her Hair...Look Out

Jennifer Aniston hacked off all the hair that she was famous for immediately after her wedding to Brad Pitt, and later told Vanity Fair about the tremendous stress she was under during and after the wedding and how the first year of their marriage has been the hardest of her life. If you looked into the lives of every celebrity who had long hair for a time and then snipped it off, like Kim Bassinger or Meg Ryan, among others, you would find emotional stress and strife, and usually, divorce. You'd also find all that luxurious hair grown back as soon as the lady has found happiness with a new love. The only mystery here is why more people haven't caught on to this subtle, but deadly, warning sign. But why should this be? Why should a woman's hair have anything to do with her emotions? Because hair, for almost every woman, represents femininity and beauty, and sometimes, therefore, what she thinks of herself. When you deal with these aspects of a woman, emotions naturally run high. It's no accident that stressful or unpleasant days have been dubbed "bad hair days", since the emotions a woman feels when things aren't going well are almost as unpleasant as what she feels when she just can't get her hair to look nice or lie flat or conform to the style she wants. And conversely, you'll never see confident sexuality and buoyant self esteem more magnificently displayed than in a woman who has gorgeous hair and knows it. A woman's emotions are more closely linked to her hair than to any other part of her, as any woman who seeks out a wig after chemotherapy will tell you. Samson, the biblical figure who lost his power when Delilah cut off his hair, should have been written as a woman.

The Day of Atonement served as a reminder taht the daily sacxrificemade at the altar was not enough to atone for sin. The comer stood afar off, but now must draw nigh.

The Feast of Trumpets begins with Rosh Hashanah. The solemnizations continue for Ten Days of Repentance, culminating on <u>Yom Kippur</u> or the <u>Day of Atonement</u>. On this final day of the High Holy Days, Jewish tradition tells how God opens the Book of Life and studies the words, actions, and thoughts

of every person whose name he has written there. If a person's good deeds outweigh or outnumber their sinful acts, his or her name will remain inscribed in the book for another year.

When Yeshua (Jesus) died on the cross, Pilate had the words "Jesus of Nazareth, King of the Jews." I believe in Hebrew that would read Yeshua Ha'Netzeret V'mlech Ha'Yehudim. Yeshua is Jesus (Gk), Ha'Netzeret is "of Nazareth, V'mlech is "the King" and Yehudim is from Yehuda or of Judah, the tribe from which Yeshua descended. By taking the first letters of each of these four words we get Y-H-V-H, or YHVH, the tetragrammaton of Y_hw_h or Y_hv_H (Yahweh).

The **tetragrammaton** (from <u>Greek</u> *τετραγράμματον*, meaning "four letters")[1][2] is the Hebrew <u>theonym</u>, commonly <u>transliterated</u> into Latin letters as **YHWH**. It is one of the <u>names of the God of Israel</u> used in the <u>Hebrew Bible</u>.

While YHWH is the most common transliteration of the tetragrammaton in English academic studies, the alternatives YHVH, JHVH and JHWH are also used.[3][4]

Although <u>Yahweh</u> is favored by most Hebrew scholars and is widely accepted as the vocalization of the Tetragrammaton, <u>Jehovah</u> is still used in some translations of the Bible. The <u>Samaritans</u> understood the pronunciation to be <u>iabe</u>. Some <u>patristic</u> sources give evidence for a Greek pronunciation <u>iaō</u>.[5]

As religiously observant <u>Jews</u> are forbidden to say or write the Tetragrammaton in full, when reading the Torah they use the word <u>Adonai</u>.[5] And although most Christians have no prohibition on vocalizing the Tetragrammaton, in most Christian translations of the Bible, "LORD" is used in place of the Tetragrammaton, after the Hebrew <u>Adonai</u>, and is often written with <u>small capitals</u> (or in all caps) to distinguish it from other words translated as "Lord".

The name may be derived from a verb that means "to be, to exist".[1]

HEBREWS 9:24» 24 † For Christ is not entered into the holy places made with hands, which are the figures of the true; but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us:

HEBREWS 9:25» 25 [†] Nor yet that he should offer himself often, as the high priest entereth into the holy place every year with blood of others;

HEBREWS 9:26» 26 † For then must he often have suffered since the foundation of the world: but now once in the end of the world hath he appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of himself.

HEBREWS 10:20» 20 † By a new and living way, which he hath consecrated for us, through the veil, that is to say, his flesh;

HEBREWS 10:21» 21 † And having an high priest over the house of God;

HEBREWS 10:22» 22 † Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water.

HEBREWS 10:23» 23 † Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for he is faithful that promised;)

HEBREWS 10:24» 24 † And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works:

HEBREWS 10:25» 25 † Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching.

HEBREWS 11:1» 1 † ¶ Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

HEBREWS 11:2» 2 † For by it the elders obtained a good report.

HEBREWS 11:3» 3 † Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear.

Hebrews 12 - Service or Sanctification

HEBREWS 12:1» 1 † ¶ Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us,

HEBREWS 12:5» 5 † And ye have forgotten the exhortation which speaketh unto you as unto children, My son, despise not thou the chastening of the Lord, nor faint when thou art rebuked of him:

HEBREWS 12:7» 7 † If ye endure chastening, God dealeth with you as with sons; for what son is he whom the father chasteneth not?

HEBREWS 12:8» 8 † But if ye be without chastisement, whereof all are partakers, then are ye bastards, and not sons.

HEBREWS 12:9» 9 † Furthermore we have had fathers of our flesh which corrected us, and we gave them reverence: shall we not much rather be in subjection unto the Father of spirits, and live?

HEBREWS 12:10> 10 † For they verily for a few days chastened us after their own pleasure; but he for our profit, that we might be partakers of his holiness.

HEBREWS 12:24» 24 [†] And to Jesus the mediator of the new covenant, and to the blood of sprinkling, that speaketh better things than that of Abel.

Hebrews 13 - Baptism of the Holy Ghost - God Does Not Change

HEBREWS 13:1» 1 † ¶ Let brotherly love continue.

HEBREWS 13:2» 2 † Be not forgetful to entertain strangers: for thereby some have entertained angels unawares.

HEBREWS 13:3» 3 † Remember them that are in bonds, as bound with them; and them which suffer adversity, as being yourselves also in the body.

HEBREWS 13:4» 4 † Marriage is honourable in all, and the bed undefiled: but whoremongers and adulterers God will judge.

HEBREWS 13:5» 5 † Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.

HEBREWS 13:6» 6 † So that we may boldly say, The Lord is my helper, and I will not fear what man shall do unto me.

HEBREWS 13:7» 7 † Remember them which have the rule over you, who have spoken unto you the word of God: whose faith follow, considering the end of their conversation.

HEBREWS 13:8» 8 † Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.

HEBREWS 13:9» 9 † Be not carried about with divers and strange doctrines. For it is a good thing that the heart be established with grace; not with meats, which have not profited them that have been occupied therein.

HEBREWS 13:10» 10 † We have an altar, whereof they have no right to eat which serve the tabernacle.

HEBREWS 13:11» 11 † For the bodies of those beasts, whose blood is brought into the sanctuary by the high priest for sin, are burned without the camp.

HEBREWS 13:12» 12 † Wherefore Jesus also, that he might sanctify the people with his own blood, suffered without the gate.

HEBREWS 13:13» 13 † Let us go forth therefore unto him without the camp, bearing his reproach.

HEBREWS 13:14» 14 † For here have we no continuing city, but we seek one to come.

HEBREWS 13:15» 15 † By him therefore let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of our lips giving thanks to his name.

HEBREWS 13:16» 16 † But to do good and to communicate forget not: for with such sacrifices God is well pleased.

HEBREWS 13:17» 17 † Obey them that have the rule over you, and submit yourselves: for they watch for your souls, as they that must give account, that they may do it with joy, and not with grief: for that is unprofitable for you.

HEBREWS 13:18» 18 † ¶ Pray for us: for we trust we have a good conscience, in all things willing to live honestly.

HEBREWS 13:19» 19 † But I beseech you the rather to do this, that I may be restored to you the sooner.

HEBREWS 13:20» 20 † Now the God of peace, that brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant,

HEBREWS 13:21» 21 [†] Make you perfect in every good work to do his will, working in you that which is wellpleasing in his sight, through Jesus Christ; to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen.
