# 14-0810am - The Year of Jubilee (The Acceptable Year of The Lord) - George Quinn

#### LEVITICUS 25:1-13

» 1 <sup>+</sup> ¶ And the LORD spake unto Moses in mount Sinai, saying,

» **2** <sup>+</sup> Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, When ye come into the land which I give you, then shall the land keep a sabbath unto the LORD.

» **3** <sup>+</sup> Six years thou shalt sow thy field, and six years thou shalt prune thy vineyard, and gather in the fruit thereof;

» **4** <sup>+</sup> But in the seventh year shall be a sabbath of rest unto the land, a sabbath for the LORD: thou shalt neither sow thy field, nor prune thy vineyard.

» **5** <sup>+</sup> That which groweth of its own accord of thy harvest thou shalt not reap, neither gather the grapes of thy vine undressed: for it is a year of rest unto the land.

And the sabbath of the land shall be meat for you; for thee, and for thy servant, and for thy maid, and for thy hired servant, and for thy stranger that sojourneth with thee,

» **7** <sup>†</sup> And for thy cattle, and for the beast that are in thy land, shall all the increase thereof be meat.

 $\mathbf{s} = \mathbf{s} + \mathbf{q}$  And thou shalt number seven sabbaths of years unto thee, seven times seven years; and the space of the seven sabbaths of years shall be unto thee forty and nine years.

» **9** <sup>+</sup> Then shalt thou cause the trumpet of the jubile to sound on the tenth day of the seventh month, in the day of atonement shall ye make the trumpet sound throughout all your land.

» **10** <sup>+</sup> And ye shall hallow the fiftieth year, and proclaim liberty throughout all the land unto all the inhabitants thereof: it shall be a jubile unto you; and ye shall return every man unto his possession, and ye shall return every man unto his family.

» **11** <sup>†</sup> A jubile shall that fiftieth year be unto you: ye shall not sow, neither reap that which groweth of itself in it, nor gather the grapes in it of thy vine undressed.

» **12** <sup>+</sup> For it is the jubile; it shall be holy unto you: ye shall eat the increase thereof out of the field.

**13** <sup>†</sup> In the year of this jubile ye shall return every man unto his possession.

#### EXODUS 21:1-6

>>

» **1** <sup>+</sup> **¶** Now these are the judgments which thou shalt set before them.

» **2** <sup>†</sup> If thou buy an Hebrew servant, six years he shall serve: and in the seventh he shall go out free for nothing.

\* **3** + If he came in by himself, he shall go out by himself: if he were married, then his wife shall go out with him.

» **4** <sup>†</sup> If his master have given him a wife, and she have born him sons or daughters; the wife and her children shall be her master's, and he shall go out by himself.

S + And if the servant shall plainly say, I love my master, my wife, and my children; I will not go out free:

» **6** <sup>†</sup> Then his master shall bring him unto the judges; he shall also bring him to the door, or unto the door post; and his master shall bore his ear through with an aul; and he shall serve him for ever.

## **LEVITICUS 16:11-17**

\* 11 <sup>+</sup> And Aaron shall bring the bullock of the sin offering, which is for himself, and shall make an atonement for himself, and for his house, and shall kill the bullock of the sin offering which is for himself:
\* 12 <sup>+</sup> And he shall take a censer full of burning coals of fire from off the altar before the LORD, and

his hands full of sweet incense beaten small, and bring it within the vail:

\* 13 <sup>+</sup> And he shall put the incense upon the fire before the LORD, that the cloud of the incense may cover the mercy seat that is upon the testimony, that he die not:

\* 14 + And he shall take of the blood of the bullock, and sprinkle it with his finger upon the mercy seat eastward; and before the mercy seat shall he sprinkle of the blood with his finger seven times.

\* 15 <sup>+</sup> ¶ Then shall he kill the goat of the sin offering, that is for the people, and bring his blood within the vail, and do with that blood as he did with the blood of the bullock, and sprinkle it upon the mercy seat, and before the mercy seat:

» **16** <sup>+</sup> And he shall make an atonement for the holy place, because of the uncleanness of the children of Israel, and because of their transgressions in all their sins: and so shall he do for the tabernacle of the congregation, that remaineth among them in the midst of their uncleanness.

\* 17 + And there shall be no man in the tabernacle of the congregation when he goeth in to make an atonement in the holy place, until he come out, and have made an atonement for himself, and for his household, and for all the congregation of Israel.

# **HEBREWS 9:11**

**11** <sup>+</sup> But Christ being come an high priest of good things to come, by a greater and more perfect tabernacle, not made with hands, that is to say, not of this building;

## LEVITICUS 23:1-44

» 1 <sup>+</sup> ¶ And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying,

» 2 + Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, Concerning the feasts of the LORD, which ye shall proclaim to be holy convocations, even these are my feasts.

» **3** <sup>+</sup> Six days shall work be done: but the seventh day is the sabbath of rest, an holy convocation; ye shall do no work therein: it is the sabbath of the LORD in all your dwellings.

\* **4** <sup>+</sup> **¶** These are the feasts of the LORD, even holy convocations, which ye shall proclaim in their seasons.

**5** <sup>+</sup> In the fourteenth day of the first month at even is the LORD'S passover.

Solution of the same month is the feast of unleavened bread unto the LORD: seven days ye must eat unleavened bread.

» **7** <sup>+</sup> In the first day ye shall have an holy convocation: ye shall do no servile work therein.

8 <sup>+</sup> But ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD seven days: in the seventh day is an holy convocation: ye shall do no servile work therein.

» **9** <sup>+</sup> And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying,

» 10 <sup>+</sup> Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, When ye be come into the land which I give unto you, and shall reap the harvest thereof, then ye shall bring a sheaf of the firstfruits of your harvest unto the priest:

\* 11 <sup>+</sup> And he shall wave the sheaf before the LORD, to be accepted for you: on the morrow after the sabbath the priest shall wave it.

**12** <sup>+</sup> And ye shall offer that day when ye wave the sheaf an he lamb without blemish of the first year for a burnt offering unto the LORD.

» **13** <sup>+</sup> And the meat offering thereof shall be two tenth deals of fine flour mingled with oil, an offering made by fire unto the LORD for a sweet savour: and the drink offering thereof shall be of wine, the fourth part of an hin.

» 14 <sup>+</sup> And ye shall eat neither bread, nor parched corn, nor green ears, until the selfsame day that ye have brought an offering unto your God: it shall be a statute for ever throughout your generations in all your dwellings.

\* 15 + ¶ And ye shall count unto you from the morrow after the sabbath, from the day that ye brought the sheaf of the wave offering; seven sabbaths shall be complete:

» **16** <sup>+</sup> Even unto the morrow after the seventh sabbath shall ye number fifty days; and ye shall offer a new meat offering unto the LORD.

**17** <sup>+</sup> Ye shall bring out of your habitations two wave loaves of two tenth deals: they shall be of fine flour; they shall be baken with leaven; they are the firstfruits unto the LORD.

\* 18 <sup>+</sup> And ye shall offer with the bread seven lambs without blemish of the first year, and one young bullock, and two rams: they shall be for a burnt offering unto the LORD, with their meat offering, and their drink offerings, even an offering made by fire, of sweet savour unto the LORD.

**19** <sup>†</sup> Then ye shall sacrifice one kid of the goats for a sin offering, and two lambs of the first year for a sacrifice of peace offerings.

» **20** <sup>+</sup> And the priest shall wave them with the bread of the firstfruits for a wave offering before the LORD, with the two lambs: they shall be holy to the LORD for the priest.

21 <sup>+</sup> And ye shall proclaim on the selfsame day, that it may be an holy convocation unto you: ye shall do no servile work therein: it shall be a statute for ever in all your dwellings throughout your generations.
22 <sup>+</sup> And when ye reap the harvest of your land, thou shalt not make clean riddance of the corners of thy field when thou reapest, neither shalt thou gather any gleaning of thy harvest: thou shalt leave them unto the poor, and to the stranger: I am the LORD your God.

» 23 <sup>+</sup> ¶ And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying,

» **24** <sup>+</sup> Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, In the seventh month, in the first day of the month, shall ye have a sabbath, a memorial of blowing of trumpets, an holy convocation.

» **25** <sup>+</sup> Ye shall do no servile work therein: but ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD.

» **26** <sup>†</sup> And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying,

» **27** <sup>+</sup> Also on the tenth day of this seventh month there shall be a day of atonement: it shall be an holy convocation unto you; and ye shall afflict your souls, and offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD.

» **28** <sup>+</sup> And ye shall do no work in that same day: for it is a day of atonement, to make an atonement for you before the LORD your God.

» **29** <sup>†</sup> For whatsoever soul it be that shall not be afflicted in that same day, he shall be cut off from among his people.

» **30** <sup>+</sup> And whatsoever soul it be that doeth any work in that same day, the same soul will I destroy from among his people.

» **31** <sup>+</sup> Ye shall do no manner of work: it shall be a statute for ever throughout your generations in all your dwellings.

**32** <sup>+</sup> It shall be unto you a sabbath of rest, and ye shall afflict your souls: in the ninth day of the month at even, from even unto even, shall ye celebrate your sabbath.

» **33** <sup>†</sup> ¶ And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying,

**34** <sup>†</sup> Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, The fifteenth day of this seventh month shall be the feast of tabernacles for seven days unto the LORD.

» **35** <sup>+</sup> On the first day shall be an holy convocation: ye shall do no servile work therein.

» **36** <sup>+</sup> Seven days ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD: on the eighth day shall be an holy convocation unto you; and ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD: it is a solemn assembly; and ye shall do no servile work therein.

» **37** <sup>+</sup> These are the feasts of the LORD, which ye shall proclaim to be holy convocations, to offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD, a burnt offering, and a meat offering, a sacrifice, and drink offerings, every thing upon his day:

**38** <sup>+</sup> Beside the sabbaths of the LORD, and beside your gifts, and beside all your vows, and beside all your freewill offerings, which ye give unto the LORD.

39 <sup>+</sup> Also in the fifteenth day of the seventh month, when ye have gathered in the fruit of the land, ye shall keep a feast unto the LORD seven days: on the first day shall be a sabbath, and on the eighth day shall be a sabbath.

**40** <sup>+</sup> And ye shall take you on the first day the boughs of goodly trees, branches of palm trees, and the boughs of thick trees, and willows of the brook; and ye shall rejoice before the LORD your God seven days.
**41** <sup>+</sup> And ye shall keep it a feast unto the LORD seven days in the year. It shall be a statute for ever in your generations: ye shall celebrate it in the seventh month.

» **42** <sup>+</sup> Ye shall dwell in booths seven days; all that are Israelites born shall dwell in booths:

\* 43 <sup>+</sup> That your generations may know that I made the children of Israel to dwell in booths, when I brought them out of the land of Egypt: I am the LORD your God.

» **44** <sup>†</sup> And Moses declared unto the children of Israel the feasts of the LORD.

## ISAIAH 61:1-2

» **1** <sup>†</sup> **¶** The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound;

» **2** <sup>+</sup> To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all that mourn;

## **REVELATION 11:3-8**

 $3^{+}$  And I will give power unto my two witnesses, and they shall prophesy a thousand two hundred and threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

**4 †** These are the two olive trees, and the two candlesticks standing before the God of the earth.

» **5** <sup>+</sup> And if any man will hurt them, fire proceedeth out of their mouth, and devoureth their enemies: and if any man will hurt them, he must in this manner be killed.

» **6** <sup>+</sup> These have power to shut heaven, that it rain not in the days of their prophecy: and have power over waters to turn them to blood, and to smite the earth with all plagues, as often as they will.

> 7 + And when they shall have finished their testimony, the beast that ascendeth out of the bottomless pit shall make war against them, and shall overcome them, and kill them.

» **8** <sup>+</sup> And their dead bodies shall lie in the street of the great city, which spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt, where also our Lord was crucified.
