Genesis 2:18-20 - 18

And the LORD God said, It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him an help meet for him.

19 And out of the ground the LORD God formed every beast of the field, and every fowl of the air; and brought them unto Adam to see what he would call them: and whatsoever Adam called every living creature, that was the name thereof.

Interesting How God Wanted to make a help meet for him and he immediately starts creating the animals.

- **20** And Adam gave names to all cattle, and to the fowl of the air, and to every beast of the field; but for Adam there was not found an help meet for him.
- **21** And the LORD God caused a deep sleep to fall upon Adam, and he slept: and he took one of his ribs, and closed up the flesh instead thereof;
- **22** And the rib, which the LORD God had taken from man, made he a woman, and brought her unto the man.
- **23** And Adam said, This is now bone of my bones, and flesh of my flesh: she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man.
- **24** Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh.
- **25** And they were both naked, the man and his wife, and were not ashamed.

- After God had created a world of delights and good for the man, yet with all of that God knew that it
 wasn't good for the man to be alone

2. God Brings The Animals To Adam To See what He Would Call Them

• 19 And out of the ground the LORD God formed every beast of the field, and every fowl of the air; and brought them unto Adam to see what he would call them:

God Gives Adam a Task - A Boy Needs a Job Before Marriage

- It's interesting to see after God said that it's not good for man to be alone, God gives him a task.
- A boy looking for a girl needs to have a job if he wants to get married. God gives Adam a job before his help mate came on the scene.

3. Adam Needed To Realize He Needed Companionship with Someone Like Him Through Naming the Animals

- So God gave man the opportunity to realize within himself that he needed companionship for someone like him. That's why **God brought him the animals to see what he would call them.**
- God wanted for Adam to exercise his faith, but at the same time realize that he needed someone
 compatible to him to fulfill that inner longing for companionship.
- God brought Adam the animals to see what he (Adam) would call them.

4. God Can't Do Everything for Us

• God can't do everything for us. Some things we have to do on our own or take them by faith.

• Numbers 33:51-53

- **51** Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, When ye are passed over Jordan into the land of Canaan;
- **52** Then ye shall drive out all the inhabitants of the land from before you, and destroy all their pictures, and destroy all their molten images, and quite pluck down all their high places:
- **53** And ye shall dispossess the inhabitants of the land, and dwell therein: for I have given you the land to possess it.

5. How Can We Be Called Overcomers...

- How else can we call ourselves overcomers in this age if we have not overcome anything ourselves.
- You appreciate things more when you work for them.

7. God Amens Adam's Word

- Verse 19 continued and whatsoever Adam called every living creature, that was the name thereof.
- God was resting in Adam that he would name the animals properly according to God's purpose and according to the revelation of his faith.
- God liked very much what Adam was naming the animals.
- Adam named the Lion The Father said Amen!
- Adam named the Elephant The Father said Amen!

- Adam named the Eagle The Father said Amen!
- Adam named the Dove The Father said Amen!
- In the Same Manner God Amens His Bride
- His Bride Will Speak Nothing but His Word.
 - Amen means So BE It.
 - The Pharaohs used to say "So Let It Be Written, So Let It Be Done!"

8. There Was not Found an Help Meet For Adam - No Compatibility for Adam

- **20** And Adam gave names to all cattle, and to the fowl of the air, and to every beast of the field; but for Adam there was not found an help meet for him.
- Adam had that longing within him, but after performing the task of naming the animals he did not find
 one of them that he was compatible too.
- He didn't find it in the Lion, He didn't find it in the Giraffe, he didn't find it in the monkey, He didn't find it in the Serpent, or Female Serpent.
- You can't find satisfaction for your soul in the earthly creatures of this world. Facebook, girlfriends, sex, alcohol, drugs etc.

9. Nothing Else Satisfies The Believer but Jesus

 To a true son of God who has a longing for true companionship, nothing else will satisfy but Jesus Christ.

10. God Does The Rest Of the work After Adam Did His

When God knew that Adam had fully exercised .his faith and had done his part and truly found out that
no one else could satisfy that longing for companionship – Then God did the rest of the work.

11. God Brings The Woman To The Man

- 21 And the LORD God caused a deep sleep to fall upon Adam, and he slept: and he took one of his ribs, and closed up the flesh instead thereof; 22 And the rib, which the LORD God had taken from man, made he a woman, and brought her unto the man.
- God created the flesh body of the woman and just as in Verse 19 where God brought to Adam the animals of the field, **God brought to Adam the woman.**

12. Adam Doesn't Give The Woman A Name. Instead He...

- 23 And Adam said, This is now bone of my bones, and flesh of my flesh: she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man.
- Notice Adam now doesn't just give the woman a name, but he says that she is bone of my bone and flesh of my flesh. In other word she's just like me.
- God doesn't see you like any other woman or church. He see's you as His sinless spotless Bride. Among the earth there is no other like the Bride of Christ.

6. Adam Came To Love and Appreciate Eve So Much...

When Eve sinned and Adam knew that he was going to lose her, Adam loved her so much and had come

to appreciate her so much that he stepped in to rescue her.

- If God would just had given Eve to Adam when he first created Adam, and if she would have sinned he might not have cared so much about getting rid of her and maybe desiring another woman.
- But because Even came out of him he loved her and appreciated her more because they were both one.

Joshua 10:5-14

- **5** Therefore the five kings of the Amorites, the king of Jerusalem, the king of Hebron, the king of Jarmuth, the king of Lachish, the king of Eglon, gathered themselves together, and went up, they and all their hosts, and encamped before Gibeon, and made war against it.
- **6** And the men of Gibeon sent unto Joshua to the camp to Gilgal, saying, Slack not thy hand from thy servants; come up to us quickly, and save us, and help us: for all the kings of the Amorites that dwell in the mountains are gathered together against us.
- **7** So Joshua ascended from Gilgal, he, and all the people of war with him, and all the mighty men of valour.
- **8** And the LORD said unto Joshua, Fear them not: for I have delivered them into thine hand; there shall not a man of them stand before thee.
- **9** Joshua therefore came unto them suddenly, and went up from Gilgal all night.
- **10** And the LORD discomfited them before Israel, and slew them with a great slaughter at Gibeon, and chased them along the way that goeth up to Bethhoron, and smote them to Azekah, and unto Makkedah.
- **11** And it came to pass, as they fled from before Israel, and were in the going down to Bethhoron, that the LORD cast down great stones from heaven upon them unto Azekah, and they died: they were more which died with hailstones than they whom the children of Israel slew with the sword.
- 12 Then spake Joshua to the LORD in the day when the LORD delivered up the Amorites before the children of Israel, and he said in the sight of Israel, Sun, stand thou still upon Gibeon; and thou, Moon, in the valley of Ajalon.
- **13** And the sun stood still, and the moon stayed, until the people had avenged themselves upon their enemies. Is not this written in the book of Jasher? So the sun stood still in the midst of heaven, and hasted not to go down about a whole day.
- **14** And there was no day like that before it or after it, that the LORD hearkened unto the voice of a man: for the LORD fought for Israel.
- When Joshua told the sun and the moon to stand still God said AMEN!
- Joshua spake and acted according to the Revelation of his faith.
- Since God had already told them to posess the land and that he had already delivered the Amorites unto them, God could not help but say Amen to his Word!
