REVELATION 1:12-15

- » 12 † And I turned to see the voice that spake with me. And being turned, I saw seven golden candlesticks;
- » 13 † And in the midst of the seven candlesticks one like unto the Son of man, clothed with a garment down to the foot, and girt about the paps with a golden girdle.
- » 14 † His head and his hairs were white like wool, as white as snow; and his eyes were as a flame of fire;
- » 15 † And his feet like unto fine brass, as if they burned in a furnace; and his voice as the sound of many waters.

- » 13 † In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise,
- » 14 † Which is the earnest of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, unto the praise of his glory.

And that's why I think, today, we have (so many) not so many, rather, genuine new Births, is because the seed is, maybe, will sympathize with the Word or the person, but they don't want to rot away from the old system that they were in.
