# End time Evangelism

---

- ❖ In 2002, we launched a brave move to present the teachings of the Message to denominational ministerial associations.
- ❖ Since then we have presented the message to different regions of the country. God blessed the effort and whole churches embraced the Message as a result.





# The Historic Expo Seminar that started the revival in Palawan

---

- ❖ The mystery expo seminar we conducted in Rizal town in 2012 where fifty ministers from the Baptist and Pentecostal groups attended. Out of this seminar dozens of ministers have received the Message and are now sharing It with their congregation and many others.





# Buffer crop

---

- ❖ Here's a picture of the latest crop of converts in the island of Palawan. We have baptized over sixty ministers on this island and are now in the process of helping these pastors present the Message to their respective churches. We now work with over fifty churches and have baptized more than twenty whole congregations.





# Minister converts from different regions of the Philippines

---

- ❖ Converts from different regions of the country are crying out for message materials (CDs, tracts, books, tablets, laptops) to gain more knowledge about the Message and be able to share the same to their people. We have VOGR to help us but we need more than what they are willing to give.





# Equipping

---

- ❖ The next step is to equip the ministers with the correct understanding of the Message and help them get the churches established in the Word. Our church have been sending teachers to their churches to help them with ministry and promote fellowship with other message churches.





# Upgrading the houses of worship

---

- ❖ Brother Edward Segumalian, a former Bible School professor has been ejected of his house and church for teaching his people the Message of the hour.
- ❖ He has been stripped of all financial support and is now excommunicated from the group. This is now his temporary church which he erected on borrowed land.





# Providing shelter

---

- ❖ Brother Edward Segumalian and family, prominent members of Christian Fellowship, Inc., have been ejected from their home and church. The brothers had to transport this house for two kilometers so Brother Edward's family can have a temporary shelter.





# Women preachers enlightened

---

- ❖ Many women preachers like Sister Beng who graduated from Bible School and pastored for over ten years now have stopped preaching and are now helping their husbands in the ministry.





# The Ministers decide to be baptized over.

---

- ❖ We baptized more than sixty ministers over a period of four years.





# Then the congregations receive baptism

---

- ❖ Brother Lito Solo and six other brothers help me in following up on the young churches in learning the fundamentals of the message. After about a month of teaching, they decide to receive scriptural water baptism.
- ❖ The latest batch of converts came mainly from a dozen churches of the Free Methodist Movement, a split of the United Methodist Church.





# Other churches are following suit

---

- ❖ We need all the ministry that we can get to help these new churches get established in the Word. They are crying out for more of the Message.





# A lot of whole groups are waiting to be baptized over

---

- ❖ My projection is that within a year's time, most of the new pastors' congregation (numbering approximately sixty) will have been baptized the Message way. We need to send more ministers to help groups in the far flung places.





# Tribal churches

---

- ❖ Here's a picture of two tribal churches that came in in Sicud Southern Palawan. There are fifteen mountain churches like these that are now learning the Message because their tribal pastors received the Message through the expo. We help these churches educate their own children as the nearest school is eight hours away on foot.





# U.P.C. Churches coming to the Message

---

- ❖ Brother Roberto Limpiado of Puerto Princesa, Palawan just recently baptized his members in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ. He was former U.P.C.





# Family Revival Pentecostal Oneness

---

- ❖ One of the churches of the Family Revival Oneness organization whose leader, Rev, Zaldy Suson led eight of their churches in Palawan to the Message. Rev. Suson has a good grasp of the Message and is now being used of the Lord to influence other independent Pentecostal churches in Palawan and Visayas region.





# Praying for a church on donated lot

---

- ❖ The church in Caliagon, Palawan headed by Pastor Chris Mahilom is also growing in the knowledge of our Savior, Jesus Christ. They have been praying for a decent place of worship to be erected on a lot that's been donated to the church. Pastor Mahilom takes care of two congregation.





# Ministers being raised up

- ❖ Brother Eddie Garbo was regional evangelist for U.P.C. for fourteen years. Now he ministers to the young churches in the Message to encourage the people to stay with their new found truth.





# Singing Preacher

---

- ❖ Brother Edu Mamac influences other Pentecostal groups and new message converts with his ministry of teaching and singing. He makes guitars and gives them away to churches that need them.





# Husband and wife team

---

- ❖ Brother Danny and Sister Liza Gomez works amongst the poorest of the poor of the city. They have a church in Sicsican, Puerto Princesa City. They also operate a day care center for indigent pupils in the village.





# Struggling Day Care Center

---

- ❖ Fifty six children are enrolled in this Day Care Center. Pastor Gomez thought about closing it down for lack of finances. We are presently helping with salaries of two teachers and some school supply. The children badly need a good feeding program.

# Strike while iron is hot

---

- ❖ Not everyone like the Message we present. The ones who reject the message are quick to spread the word around. Time will come when we will not be able to conduct seminars as denominational leaders have been marking us as Branhamites. This particular group is hostile to the Message being dominated by women preachers.





# Big groups want big seminars

---

- ❖ This particular Full Gospel group wants big seminars where hundreds of their minister members will attend. We are not quite ready for such expensive endeavors. Most of my seminars are small groups of thirty to fifty which is cheaper and a lot more easier to handle.





# Follow up

---

- ❖ Follow up seminars are conducted amongst respondents where they are taught the deeper things of God and their questions systematically answered.
