# **GENESIS 15:8-21**

» 8 <sup>+</sup> And he said, Lord GOD, whereby shall I know that I shall inherit it?

» 9 <sup>+</sup> And he said unto him, Take me an heifer of three years old, and a she goat of three years old,

and a ram of three years old, and a turtledove, and a young pigeon.

» 10 <sup>+</sup> And he took unto him all these, and divided them in the midst, and laid each piece one against another: but the birds divided he not.

» 11 <sup>+</sup> And when the fowls came down upon the carcases, Abram drove them away.

 $\sim$  12 <sup>+</sup> ¶ And when the sun was going down, a deep sleep fell upon Abram; and, lo, an horror of great darkness fell upon him.

» 13 <sup>+</sup> And he said unto Abram, Know of a surety that thy seed shall be a stranger in a land that is not theirs, and shall serve them; and they shall afflict them four hundred years;

» 14 <sup>+</sup> And also that nation, whom they shall serve, will I judge: and afterward shall they come out with great substance.

 $\sim 15$  + And thou shalt go to thy fathers in peace; thou shalt be buried in a good old age.

» 16 <sup>+</sup> But in the fourth generation they shall come hither again: for the iniquity of the Amorites is not yet full.

 $\sim$  17 <sup>+</sup> ¶ And it came to pass, that, when the sun went down, and it was dark, behold a smoking furnace, and a burning lamp that passed between those pieces.

» 18 <sup>+</sup> In the same day the LORD made a covenant with Abram, saying, Unto thy seed have I given this land, from the river of Egypt unto the great river, the river Euphrates:

» 19 <sup>+</sup> The Kenites, and the Kenizzites, and the Kadmonites,

» 20 <sup>+</sup> And the Hittites, and the Perizzites, and the Rephaims,

» 21 <sup>+</sup> And the Amorites, and the Canaanites, and the Girgashites, and the Jebusites.

# **HEBREWS 6:13-20**

» 13 <sup>+</sup> For when God made promise to Abraham, because he could swear by no greater, he sware by himself,

» 14 <sup>+</sup> Saying, Surely blessing I will bless thee, and multiplying I will multiply thee.

» 15 <sup>+</sup> And so, after he had patiently endured, he obtained the promise.

» 16 <sup>†</sup> For men verily swear by the greater: and an oath for confirmation is to them an end of all strife.

» 17 <sup>+</sup> Wherein God, willing more abundantly to shew unto the heirs of promise the immutability of his counsel, confirmed it by an oath:

» 18 <sup>+</sup> That by two immutable things, in which it was impossible for God to lie, we might have a strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the hope set before us:

» 19 + Which hope we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and stedfast, and which entereth into that within the veil;

 $\sim$  20 <sup>+</sup> Whither the forerunner is for us entered, even Jesus, made an high priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec.
