## 15-0902 - Unconditional Covenant Pt.9 (Do We Believe In or On) - Samuel Dale

### GENESIS 12:1-3

- » **1** † ¶ Now the LORD had said unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will shew thee:
- » **2** † And I will make of thee a great nation, and I will bless thee, and make thy name great; and thou shalt be a blessing:
- » **3** † And I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee: and in thee shall all families of the earth be blessed.

### GALATIANS 3:6-9

- » **6** † ¶ Even as Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness.
- » **7** † Know ye therefore that they which are of faith, the same are the children of Abraham.
- » **8** † And the scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the heathen through faith, preached before the gospel unto Abraham, saying, In thee shall all nations be blessed.
- » **9** † So then they which be of faith are blessed with faithful Abraham.

### 1) ROMANS 2:28-29

- » **28** † For he is not a Jew, which is one outwardly; neither is that circumcision, which is outward in the flesh:
- » **29** † But he is a Jew, which is one inwardly; and circumcision is that of the heart, in the spirit, and not in the letter; whose praise is not of men, but of God.

- » **6** † ¶ Even as Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness.

- » **16** † **Come and hear, all ye that fear God, and I will declare what he hath done for my soul.**
- » **17** † I cried unto him with my mouth, and he was extolled with my tongue.
- » **18** † If I regard iniquity in my heart, the Lord will not hear me:
- » **19** † But verily God hath heard me; he hath attended to the voice of my prayer.
- » **20** † Blessed be God, which hath not turned away my prayer, nor his mercy from me.

- » **8** † The centurion answered and said, Lord, I am not worthy that thou shouldest come under my roof: but speak the word only, and my servant shall be healed.
- » **9** † For I am a man under authority, having soldiers under me: and I say to this man, Go, and he goeth; and to another, Come, and he cometh; and to my servant, Do this, and he doeth it.
- » **10** † When Jesus heard it, he marvelled, and said to them that followed, **Verily I say unto you, I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel.**

- » **22** † And, behold, a woman of Canaan came out of the same coasts, and cried unto him, saying, Have mercy on me, O Lord, thou Son of David; my daughter is grievously vexed with a devil.
- » **23** † But he answered her not a word. And his disciples came and besought him, saying, Send her away; for she crieth after us.
- » **24** † But he answered and said, **I am not sent but unto the lost sheep of the house of Israel.**
- » **25** † Then came she and worshipped him, saying, Lord, help me.
- » **26** † But he answered and said, **It is not meet to take the children's bread, and to cast it to dogs.**
- » **27** † And she said, Truth, Lord: yet the dogs eat of the crumbs which fall from their masters' table.
- » **28** † Then Jesus answered and said unto her, **O woman, great is thy faith: be it unto thee even as thou wilt.** And her daughter was made whole from that very hour.

## 6) ROMANS 4:23-24

» **23** † ¶ Now it was not written for his sake alone, that it was imputed to him;  
» **24** † But for us also, to whom it shall be imputed, if we believe on him that raised up Jesus our Lord from the dead;

## 7) 63-0119 THE.WAY.OF.A.TRUE.PROPHET\_ PHOENIX.AZ SATURDAY\_

« **286** † Now, here is upon a basis. Now, if I--if I was our Lord Jesus standing here, and this woman was sick, you know I could not heal her if I was the Lord Jesus. I couldn't do it, 'cause I had already done it. Now, how many knows that's true? [Congregation says, "Amen."--Ed.] See? Certainly.

**287** He has already forgive every sin. He's already healed every sick person. He's already appropriated that Blood at the Calvary. **The price is already paid. It's all paid. But the only thing you have to do is to accept It, believe It and accept It. And you cannot accept It until first you believe It. See? Believe the Gospel.**

## 9) 65-0426 PROVING.HIS.WORD\_ LOS.ANGELES.CA V-18 N-3 MONDAY\_

« **72** † You've heard people say, "Seeing is believing." That's not altogether true. Many people see and they still don't believe.

**73** The days that Jesus was on earth, why didn't they recognize Him, that He was that Word of God made manifest? Why didn't the people realize that Moses said, "The Lord your God shall rise up a prophet likened unto me"? And He fulfilled every Word that the Bible spoke that He would do, but they didn't believe it.

**74** But God, in every age, has proved His Word to be true. He always proves His Word. **Then they say sometimes, that, "Seeing is believing." It isn't so. But we know that God goes right on proving His Word in every age.**

**75** We know that He proved it to Adam and Eve, that when He said, "The day you eat thereof, that day you shall surely die." We have to admit to that, that that's truth. We believe that, for He has proved it to us, and we know that it's the truth.

## 10) 63-0825E PERFECT.FAITH\_ JEFFERSONVILLE.IN V-6 N-11 SUNDAY\_

« **48** † Now, other words, I'm venturing out, "Well, I'll go. The Bible said, 'Call the elders, let them anoint with oil, pray over it.' I know, I'll go up." And you say, "Well, I'm going to be healed." See, you're making yourself; you don't watch now, you're going to make yourself just--just worked up. Then when he pass through, he say, "Oh, I--I still don't see." See, there you was, you didn't have faith!

**49** Your genuine faith will do it right there. Your--your genuine faith will make it so real to you that... Look at that little woman with the blood issue, she said, "If I can only touch the border of His garment, I'll be made well." And as soon as she did it, she said she "felt within herself that her blood issue stopped." She actually believed it.

**50** And when she touched It... to prove that it stopped--it stopped, Jesus turned and said, "Who touched Me?" That Perfect Faith! And that same Perfect Faith tonight, will touch Jesus Christ just as it did then. **The woman come with a Perfect Faith for that time.**

« **51** † **Now, now we see, at first the disciples didn't have this Perfect Faith. They didn't have it, because they'd had Christ, walking with Him; but then afterwards, Christ was in them. And so, you see, it's hard then to have this Perfect Faith without the Holy Spirit; It has to bring it, It does.** Now, you say, "The disciples didn't have Perfect Faith?" No; for they had an epileptic child there, that they were trying to cast this devil out of him, and they couldn't do it.

**52** And the father seen Jesus coming, and he said, "We have brought my son to--to Your disciples, and they could not cure him." See?

**53** And afterwards, the disciples asked Jesus, saying, "Why could not we cure him?"

**54** And Jesus said, "Because, of the lack of faith, of your unbelief." That's right. "Because of your unbelief at..."

« **E-30 †** Now, Cain belonged to church. He is a confess; he believed on God. He wasn't a hypocrite; he believed God. He worshipped God. And he belonged to church, an altar. He brought a sacrifice and offered it, and knelt down and prayed and made his confession.
