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16-0306am - New Race (Another Creation) - What Will Your Faith Produce Pt.10 - Samuel Dale

REVELATION 3:14

» 14 † ¶ And unto the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write; These things saith the Amen, the faithful and true witness, the beginning of the creation of God;

EPHESIANS 2:1-8

» 1 † ¶ And you hath he quickened, who were dead in trespasses and sins;
» 2 † Wherein in time past ye walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience:
» 3 † Among whom also we all had our conversation in times past in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind; and were by nature the children of wrath, even as others.
» 4 † ¶ But God, who is rich in mercy, for his great love wherewith he loved us,
» 5 † Even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;)
» 6 † And hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus:
» 7 † That in the ages to come he might shew the exceeding riches of his grace in his kindness toward us through Christ Jesus.
» 8 † For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God:

1) 64-0726E BROKEN.CISTERNS_ JEFFERSONVILLE.IN V-5 N-13 SUNDAY_

« 66 † Today I was talking with my good friend, Doctor Lee Vayle, who is present now. And he's quite a theologian, and so we usually have some--have some pretty good discussions on the Scripture. Very smart.

And he asked me one time what I thought about the initial evidence of the Holy Ghost, "Was it speaking in tongues?" It's been many years ago.

I said, "No; can't see that."

He said, "Neither do I," said, "though I've been taught that." **He said, "What would you think would be an evidence?"**

67 I said, "The most perfect evidence I can think of is love." And so we got to talking on that.

And then I thought that sounded pretty good so I just held that, "If a man has got love."

But one day the Lord, in a vision, straightened me out. And He said, that, "The evidence of the Spirit was those who could receive the Word," neither love, nor speaking in tongues, but it's receiving the Word.

2) « 169-3 † PERGAMEAN.CHURCH.AGE - CHURCH.AGE.BOOK CPT.5

The evidence of receiving the Holy Ghost today is just the same as it was back in the day of our Lord. It is receiving the Word of truth for the day in which you live. Jesus never did stress the importance of the Works as He did the Word. He knew that if the people got the WORD the works would follow. That is Bible.

3) « 143-2 † SMYRNAEAN.CHURCH.AGE - CHURCH.AGE.BOOK CPT.4

In every age, (and every age is the age of the Holy Ghost for the true believer)--I say, in every age the evidence was the same. Those who had the Spirit, the Teacher, heard the Word, and that Spirit in them took the Word and taught it (revealed it) to them; and they were of the group that heard the messenger and his message and took it and lived it.

4) HEBREWS 13:8

» 8 † **Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.**

5) MALACHI 3:6

» 6 † **For I am the LORD, I change not;** therefore ye sons of Jacob are not consumed

6) 63-0728 CHRIST.IS.THE.MYSTERY.OF.GOD.REVEALED_ JEFFERSONVILLE.IN V-3 N-7 SUNDAY_
« **233** † Look, Christ in you makes Him the center of Life of the revelation. See? Christ's Life in you makes Him the center of the revelation. **Christ, in the Bible, makes the Bible the complete revelation of Christ. Christ in you makes you the complete revelation of the whole thing, see, what God is trying to do.**

234 **What is the new Birth then? You'd say, "Well, Brother Branham, what is the new Birth?" It is the revelation of Jesus Christ personally to you. Amen! See? Not you joined a church, you shook a hand, you done something different, you said a creed, you promised to live by a--a code of rules. But Christ, the Bible, He is the Word that was revealed to you. And no matter what anybody says, what takes place, it's Christ; pastor, priest, whatever it might be. It's Christ in you, that is the revelation that the Church was built upon.**

« **235** † You say, "Well, I'm a Lutheran. I'm a Baptist. I'm Presbyterian." That don't mean one, don't mean [Brother Branham snaps his finger--Ed.] that to God, not a thing, not a snap of your finger.

236 **What is it? It's Christ being revealed, and He is the Word. And when the Word is revealed, It expresses Itself.** See? That's God's purpose for Jesus Christ, was to express Himself, to take His Own laws and live by His laws, con-... and fulfill His law, by death. And Christ, God, died in flesh, in order to condemn sin in the flesh, that He might bring to Himself a glorious Bride, redeemed back, that will believe only in the Word of God; and not swap It, like Eve did, for intellectual conceptions of man. You see it? That's Christ's idea. That's God's idea. The new Birth reveals this.

« **237** † **And if a man says he is born again, and try to place these promises of Christ, in this last days, to some other age, making Him Christ yesterday but not today, then that man or that person has been in a--a delusion by Satan.** And if that man says that he believes That, and it doesn't manifest itself through him?

238 Jesus said, in Mark 16, "These signs shall follow them that believe; into all the world, and to every age." Casting out devils, and speaking with tongues, and--and all these great manifestations of gifts that would follow, that, "they shall!" Not, "they may be; they ought to." "They will!" And heavens and earth will pass away, but His Word won't.

7) 60-1204E THE.PATMOS.VISION_ JEFFERSONVILLE.IN ROJC 69-130 SUNDAY_
« **71** † **Now ask God to... while we're talking on Revelation, ask Him to give you a revelation of This. For It can only be known by revelation, and you can only be saved by revelation. You have a knowledge of It, intellectually, but you can't be saved until It's revealed to you. "No man can call Jesus the Christ, only by the Holy Ghost."** That's what the Bible says. No man can say Jesus is the Christ until he has received the Holy Ghost. He might say, "The pastor says so, the Bible says so." Them are truths. "The church says so." That is true. **But you don't know yourself until the Holy Ghost has revealed It to you, and He's become in you. "No man can call Jesus the Christ, only by the Holy Ghost." Not by knowledge, not by intellectual.**

8) 64-0415 CHRIST.IS.IDENTIFIED.THE.SAME.IN.ALL.GENERATIONS_ TAMPA.FL WEDNESDAY_
« **38** † We've been, had great schools and seminaries. Of course, when we get that, we begin to get men with ideas, and they inject in. If two men started out, agree to make--make a--a--an organization, and as good as it is, yet, within a year's time, there'd be all kinds of things injected in that organization, 'cause you get different ideas. And diff-... **So, it's all right, it keeps a brotherhood, and nothing against it. But, the thing of it is, you're not saved by your organization, by your denomination.**

39 **You're saved by your own personal faith in Jesus Christ. That's all. So it's between you and Christ, alone. So you seek out the Scripture, and believe Him with all your heart, and--and He'll save you, or heal you. If He doesn't keep His Word, then He isn't God; and if He does keep His Word, It proves He's God. See? So, He, we believe Him with all of our heart.**

9) 60-0911M AS.I.WAS.WITH.MOSES.SO.I.WILL.BE.WITH.THEE_ JEFFERSONVILLE.IN V-16 N-2 SUNDAY_
« **228** † **Remember, you can only be saved by your personal faith. You can only be healed by your personal faith. You believe this to be the Bible? God's Word. You believe your pastor to be a man of God, whatever church you go to? If you don't, you should leave it. Get to a man that is a man of God. Then if you believe him, believe he's telling you the truth, then accept it. Your own personal faith in Christ saves you. No matter how good your pastor is, how godly, saintly your mother is, how--how real the Word of God is, how much you cry, how much you pray; it's your faith that saves you. By faith are you saved.**

Now, the same thing applies. No matter how... God's Word said that He would send this in the last days. Two straight sermons now, I brought natural Israel and spiritual Israel together. We're looking for the Joshua of this day, which is the Holy Spirit, to lead us to the land. He has to speak through somebody, because He's a Spirit. I've told you what He's told me. Now, you believe and be healed.

9) 58-0105 HAVE.FAITH.IN.GOD_ CHICAGO.IL SUNDAY_

« E-6 † Now, some thinks that it's a mental conception of the Word, but that is not right. Faith is a substance. **Faith is not a myth. Say... Faith is a substance of things hoped for; the evidence... To have an evidence, it must be a substance. So it is not just something that you imagine in your mind; it's something that absolutely, you have. It's something that you possess in your own being. And what is it? It's the evidence of things that you have hoped for. It's the evidence of things you do not have as yet, but you have the authority of God to say that you have it. It's an evidence, something you have in your heart.**

10) 63-0825E PERFECT.FAITH_ JEFFERSONVILLE.IN V-6 N-11 SUNDAY_

« 114 † **And so when a man lives by faith and walks by faith, I mean substance faith, he is isolated from the entire world and becomes a new creature in Christ. There, now you're getting into Bride material.** See? See? See? You're getting into rapturing condition, now. That means for each one of us; not just the pastor, deacons, trustees. That means for the laity, every individual walks in a world with God alone. You're baptized into this Kingdom, and there's nobody in there but you and God. See? He gives the orders, and you pack them out. Whatever He says, there's not a shadow of doubt nowhere, you walk right on. If the Lord says this, there's nobody in the world can talk you out of it, you go right on just the same. Now you're coming into Perfect Faith, perfect perfection that cannot fail. That faith never fails. Yes, He was a mystic to them with His Perfect Faith; and so is it now with those who have Perfect Faith, are a mystic to others.

HEBREWS 11:1-40

- » 1 † ¶ Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.
- » 2 † For by it the elders obtained a good report.
- » 3 † Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear.
- » 4 † ¶ **By faith Abel offered unto God** a more excellent sacrifice than Cain, by which he obtained witness that he was righteous, God testifying of his gifts: and by it he being dead yet speaketh.
- » 5 † **By faith Enoch** was translated that he should not see death; and was not found, because God had translated him: for before his translation he had this testimony, that he pleased God.
- » 6 † **But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.**
- » 7 † **By faith Noah**, being warned of God of things not seen as yet, moved with fear, prepared an ark to the saving of his house; by the which he condemned the world, and became heir of the righteousness which is by faith.
- » 8 † **By faith Abraham**, when he was called to go out into a place which he should after receive for an inheritance, obeyed; and he went out, not knowing whither he went.
- » 9 † **By faith he sojourned** in the land of promise, as in a strange country, dwelling in tabernacles with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same promise:
- » 10 † For he looked for a city which hath foundations, whose builder and maker is God.
- » 11 † **Through faith** also Sara herself received strength to conceive seed, and was delivered of a child when she was past age, because she judged him faithful who had promised.
- » 12 † Therefore sprang there even of one, and him as good as dead, so many as the stars of the sky in multitude, and as the sand which is by the sea shore innumerable.
- » 13 † These all died in faith, not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off, and were persuaded of them, and embraced them, and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth.
- » 14 † For they that say such things declare plainly that they seek a country.
- » 15 † And truly, if they had been mindful of that country from whence they came out, they might have had opportunity to have returned.
- » 16 † But now they desire a better country, that is, an heavenly: wherefore God is not ashamed to be called their God: for he hath prepared for them a city.
- » 17 † **By faith Abraham**, when he was tried, offered up Isaac: and he that had **received the promises offered up his only begotten son**,
- » 18 † Of whom it was said, That in Isaac shall thy seed be called:
- » 19 † Accounting that God was able to raise him up, even from the dead; from whence also he received him in a figure.

- » **20** † **By faith Isaac** blessed Jacob and Esau concerning things to come.
- » **21** † **By faith Jacob**, when he was a dying, blessed both the sons of Joseph; and worshipped, leaning upon the top of his staff.
- » **22** † **By faith Joseph**, when he died, made mention of the departing of the children of Israel; and gave commandment concerning his bones.
- » **23** † **By faith Moses**, when he was born, was hid three months of his parents, because they saw he was a proper child; and they were not afraid of the king's commandment.
- » **24** † **By faith Moses**, when he was come to years, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter;
- » **25** † Choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of God, than to enjoy the pleasures of sin for a season;
- » **26** † Esteeming the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures in Egypt: for he had respect unto the recompence of the reward.
- » **27** † **By faith he forsook Egypt**, not fearing the wrath of the king: for he endured, as seeing him who is invisible.
- » **28** † **Through faith he kept the passover**, and the sprinkling of blood, lest he that destroyed the firstborn should touch them.
- » **29** † **By faith they passed through the Red sea** as by dry land: which the Egyptians assaying to do were drowned.
- » **30** † **By faith the walls of Jericho fell down**, after they were compassed about seven days.
- » **31** † **By faith the harlot Rahab perished not** with them that believed not, when she had received the spies with peace.
- » **32** † ¶ And what shall I more say? for the time would fail me to tell of Gedeon, and of Barak, and of Samson, and of Jephthae; of David also, and Samuel, and of the prophets:
- » **33** † **Who through faith subdued kingdoms**, wrought righteousness, obtained promises, stopped the mouths of lions,
- » **34** † Quenched the violence of fire, escaped the edge of the sword, out of weakness were made strong, waxed valiant in fight, turned to flight the armies of the aliens.
- » **35** † Women received their dead raised to life again: and others were tortured, not accepting deliverance; that they might obtain a better resurrection:
- » **36** † And others had trial of cruel mockings and scourgings, yea, moreover of bonds and imprisonment:
- » **37** † They were stoned, they were sawn asunder, were tempted, were slain with the sword: they wandered about in sheepskins and goatskins; being destitute, afflicted, tormented;
- » **38** † (Of whom the world was not worthy:) they wandered in deserts, and in mountains, and in dens and caves of the earth.
- » **39** † **And these all, having obtained a good report through faith, received not the promise:**
- » **40** † **God having provided some better thing for us, that they without us should not be made perfect.**
