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17-0215 - The Sabbath Day - Samuel Dale

HEBREWS 3:15-19

- » **15** † While it is said, To day if ye will hear his voice, harden not your hearts, as in the provocation.
- » 16 † For some, when they had heard, did provoke: howbeit not all that came out of Egypt by Moses.
- **> 17** † But with whom was he grieved forty years? was it not with them that had sinned, whose carcases fell in the wilderness?
- » 18 † And to whom sware he that they should not enter into his rest, but to them that believed not?
- » 19 † So we see that they could not enter in because of unbelief.

HEBREWS 4:1-11

- » **1** † ¶ Let us therefore fear, lest, a promise being left us of entering into his rest, any of you should seem to come short of it.
- » **2** † For unto us was the gospel preached, as well as unto them: but the word preached did not profit them, not being mixed with faith in them that heard it.
- » **3** † For we which have believed do enter into rest, as he said, As I have sworn in my wrath, if they shall enter into my rest: although the works were finished from the foundation of the world.
- » **4** † For he spake in a certain place of the seventh day on this wise, And God did rest the seventh day from all his works.
- » **5** † And in this place again, If they shall enter into my rest.
- » **6** † Seeing therefore it remaineth that some must enter therein, and they to whom it was first preached entered not in because of unbelief:
- » **7** † Again, he limiteth a certain day, saying in David, To day, after so long a time; as it is said, To day if ye will hear his voice, harden not your hearts.
- **8** † For if Jesus had given them rest, then would he not afterward have spoken of another day.
- » 9 † There remaineth therefore a rest to the people of God.
- * 10 † For he that is entered into his rest, he also hath ceased from his own works, as God did from his.
- » **11** † ¶ Let us labour therefore to enter into that rest, lest any man fall after the same example of unbelief.

GALATIANS 4:8-11

- \gg 8 \dagger ¶ Howbeit then, when ye knew not God, ye did service unto them which by nature are no gods.
- » **9** † But now, after that ye have known God, or rather are known of God, how turn ye again to the weak and beggarly elements, whereunto ye desire again to be in bondage?
- **10** † Ye observe days, and months, and times, and years.
- » 11 † I am afraid of you, lest I have bestowed upon you labour in vain.

- **« 220 †** The sabbath speaks of the old law, which was to pass away. The keeping of a sabbath, which "passed away," or, I have said, "changed to another." It didn't pass away; it just changed from the old law, of keeping a certain day of the week.
- Isaiah, the 19th chapter, said, I believe 28:19, said, "Precept must be upon precept; here a little, and there a little." "Hold fast to that what's good." "For with stammering lips and other tongues will I speak to this people. And here is the rest." See?
- You enter into Life, not keeping a day or shadow. Paul said, over there in Hebrews the 4th chapter. "You keep days and shadows, and things like that; I'm scared of your experience." See, we don't pass into certain days and orders. "You've passed from death unto Eternal Life," not days and times. You've passed into Eternity. That's the holy convo-... convocation, convocation, rather.

- » 8 † Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy.
- » 9 † Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work:
- » **10** † **But the seventh day is the sabbath of the LORD thy God:** in it thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that is within thy gates:

« **134** † Now, let me just settle this for you and show you what day we're to keep. Now, is there a Scripture? I'll ask this for your benefit.

Is there a Scripture, Brother Branham, telling us and authorizing us to keep Sunday just like the Jews kept Saturday?

No, sir, there's not, not a Scripture in the Bible, for in the New Testament, for us to keep either Saturday or Sunday. But the reason we keep Sunday, is a memorial of the resurrection, Nothing...

Now, you're going to say, "The Roman Catholic did that." « **E-51** † Now. All of us believe that we're in the end time. Any man that's--that's intelligent, I believe, if he would look around and see, it shows this thing can't go on much longer. I want about fifteen minutes now to show you what I mean. Anyone knows that something's got to happen. All Scriptures point to it.

We are taught that the world was created in six thousand years, being a thousand a day, one day as a year with God, and so forth: six thousand years in the creation. All right. Six days it's called, and the Bible says one day is a thousand years, or a thousand years is one day with God.

- » 2 † But when the Pharisees saw it, they said unto him, Behold, thy disciples do that **which is not lawful to do upon the sabbath day.**
- But he said unto them, Have ye not read what David did, when he was an hungred, and they that were with him;
- **4** † How he entered into the house of God, and did eat the shewbread, which was not lawful for him to eat, neither for them which were with him, but only for the priests?

- » 5 † Or have ye not read in the law, how that on the sabbath days the priests in the temple profane the sabbath, and are blameless?
- But I say unto you, That in this place is one greater than the temple.
- **7** † But if ye had known what this meaneth, I will have mercy, and not sacrifice, ye would not have condemned the guiltless.
- » 8 † For the Son of man is Lord even of the sabbath day.
- » 9 † And when he was departed thence, he went into their synagogue:
- * 10 † And, behold, there was a man which had his hand withered. And they asked him, saying, Is it lawful to heal on the sabbath days? that they might accuse him.
- And he said unto them, What man shall there be among you, that shall have one sheep, and if it fall into a pit on the sabbath day, will he not lay hold on it, and lift it out?
- » 12 † How much then is a man better than a sheep? Wherefore it is lawful to do well on the sabbath days.
- **13** † Then saith he to the man, Stretch forth thine hand. And he stretched it forth; and it was restored whole, like as the other.
