JOHN 14:7-11

- **7** † If ye had known me, ye should have known my Father also: and from henceforth ye know him, and have seen him.
- » 8 † Philip saith unto him, Lord, shew us the Father, and it sufficeth us.
- » **9** † Jesus saith unto him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip? he that hath seen me hath seen the Father; and how sayest thou then, Shew us the Father?
- » **10** † Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? the words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works.
- Believe me that I am in the Father, and the Father in me: or else believe me for the very works' sake.

JOHN 2:13-16

- * 13 † And the Jews' passover was at hand, and Jesus went up to Jerusalem,
- * 14 † And found in the temple those that sold oxen and sheep and doves, and the changers of money sitting:
- » **15** † And when he had made a scourge of small cords, he drove them all out of the temple, and the sheep, and the oxen; and poured out the changers' money, and overthrew the tables;
- **16** † And said unto them that sold doves, Take these things hence; make not my Father's house an house of merchandise.

JOHN 3:1-21

- * 1 † ¶ There was a man of the Pharisees, named Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews:
- » **2** † The same came to Jesus by night, and said unto him, Rabbi, we know that thou art a teacher come from God: for no man can do these miracles that thou doest, except God be with him.
- » **3** † Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.
- » **4** † Nicodemus saith unto him, How can a man be born when he is old? can he enter the second time into his mother's womb, and be born?
- » **5** † Jesus answered, Verily, Verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.
- » **6** † That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.
- » 7 † Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.
- **8** † The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the Spirit.
- » 9 † Nicodemus answered and said unto him, How can these things be?
- y 10 † Jesus answered and said unto him, Art thou a master of Israel, and knowest not these things?
- » **11** † Verily, verily, I say unto thee, We speak that we do know, and testify that we have seen; and ye receive not our witness.
- » **12** † If I have told you earthly things, and ye believe not, how shall ye believe, if I tell you of heavenly things?
- **13** † And no man hath ascended up to heaven, but he that came down from heaven, even the Son of man which is in heaven.
- * 14 † And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of man be lifted up:
- » 15 † That whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have eternal life.
- **16** † For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
- **17** † For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved.
- » **18** † He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.
- **19** † And this is the condemnation, that light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil.
- » **20** † For every one that doeth evil hateth the light, neither cometh to the light, lest his deeds should be reproved.

» **21** † But he that doeth truth cometh to the light, that his deeds may be made manifest, that they are wrought in God.

JOHN 4:14-26

- **> 14** † But whosoever drinketh of the water that I shall give him shall never thirst; but the water that I shall give him shall be in him a well of water springing up into everlasting life.
- **15** † The woman saith unto him, Sir, give me this water, that I thirst not, neither come hither to draw.
- » 16 † Jesus saith unto her, Go, call thy husband, and come hither.
- **The woman answered and said, I have no husband.** Jesus said unto her, Thou hast well said, I have no husband:
- **18** † For thou hast had five husbands; and he whom thou now hast is not thy husband: in that saidst thou truly.
- » 19 † The woman saith unto him, Sir, I perceive that thou art a prophet.
- **20** † Our fathers worshipped in this mountain; and ye say, that in Jerusalem is the place where men ought to worship.
- » **21** † Jesus saith unto her, Woman, believe me, the hour cometh, when ye shall neither in this mountain, nor yet at Jerusalem, worship the Father.
- ye worship ye know not what: we know what we worship: for salvation is of the Jews.
- » 23 † But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him.
- **24** † God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.
- **25** † The woman saith unto him, I know that Messias cometh, which is called Christ: when he is come, he will tell us all things.
- » 26 † Jesus saith unto her, I that speak unto thee am he.

JOHN 4:31-34

- » 31 † In the mean while his disciples prayed him, saying, Master, eat.
- » **32** † But he said unto them, I have meat to eat that ye know not of.
- » 33 † Therefore said the disciples one to another, Hath any man brought him ought to eat?
- » 34 † Jesus saith unto them, My meat is to do the will of him that sent me, and to finish his work.

JOHN 5:19-39

- » **19** † Then answered Jesus and said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, The Son can do nothing of himself, but what he seeth the Father do: for what things soever he doeth, these also doeth the Son likewise.
- » **20** † For the Father loveth the Son, and sheweth him all things that himself doeth: and he will shew him greater works than these, that ye may marvel.
- » **21** † For as the Father raiseth up the dead, and quickeneth them; even so the Son quickeneth whom he will.
- » 22 † For the Father judgeth no man, but hath committed all judgment unto the Son:
- **23** † That all men should honour the Son, even as they honour the Father. He that honoureth not the Son honoureth not the Father which hath sent him.
- **24** † Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life.
- » **25** † Verily, verily, I say unto you, The hour is coming, and now is, when the dead shall hear the voice of the Son of God: and they that hear shall live.
- » 26 † For as the Father hath life in himself; so hath he given to the Son to have life in himself;
- » 27 † And hath given him authority to execute judgment also, because he is the Son of man.
- » **28** † Marvel not at this: for the hour is coming, in the which all that are in the graves shall hear his voice,
- **29** † And shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation.
- **30** † I can of mine own self do nothing: as I hear, I judge: and my judgment is just; because I seek not mine own will, but the will of the Father which hath sent me.
- **31** † ¶ If I bear witness of myself, my witness is not true.
- **32** † There is another that beareth witness of me; and I know that the witness which he witnesseth of me is true.
- y 33 † Ye sent unto John, and he bare witness unto the truth.
- » **34** † But I receive not testimony from man: but these things I say, that ye might be saved.
- 35 † He was a burning and a shining light: and ye were willing for a season to rejoice in his light.

- **36** † But I have greater witness than that of John: for the works which the Father hath given me to finish, the same works that I do, bear witness of me, that the Father hath sent me.
- **37** † And the Father himself, which hath sent me, hath borne witness of me. Ye have neither heard his voice at any time, nor seen his shape.
- 38 † And ye have not his word abiding in you: for whom he hath sent, him ye believe not.
- » 39 † Search the scriptures; for in them ye think ye have eternal life: and they are they which testify of me.

JOHN 6:28-48

- **28** † ¶ Then said they unto him, What shall we do, that we might work the works of God?
- **29** † Jesus answered and said unto them, This is the work of God, that ye believe on him whom he hath sent.
- » 30 † They said therefore unto him, What sign shewest thou then, that we may see, and believe thee? what dost thou work?
- **31** † Our fathers did eat manna in the desert; as it is written, He gave them bread from heaven to eat.
- » **32** † Then Jesus said unto them, Verily, Verily, I say unto you, Moses gave you not that bread from heaven; but my Father giveth you the true bread from heaven.
- » **33** † For the bread of God is he which cometh down from heaven, and giveth life unto the world.
- » **34** † Then said they unto him, Lord, evermore give us this bread.
- » **35** † And Jesus said unto them, I am the bread of life: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never thirst.
- » **36** † But I said unto you, That ye also have seen me, and believe not.
- **37** † All that the Father giveth me shall come to me; and him that cometh to me I will in no wise cast out.
- » 38 † For I came down from heaven, not to do mine own will, but the will of him that sent me.
- » **39** † And this is the Father's will which hath sent me, that of all which he hath given me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up again at the last day.
- **40** † And this is the will of him that sent me, that every one which seeth the Son, and believeth on him, may have everlasting life: and I will raise him up at the last day.
- **41** † The Jews then murmured at him, because he said, I am the bread which came down from heaven.
- » **42** † And they said, Is not this Jesus, the son of Joseph, whose father and mother we know? how is it then that he saith, I came down from heaven?
- y 43 † Jesus therefore answered and said unto them, Murmur not among yourselves.
- » **44** † No man can come to me, except the Father which hath sent me draw him: and I will raise him up at the last day.
- **45** † It is written in the prophets, And they shall be all taught of God. Every man therefore that hath heard, and hath learned of the Father, cometh unto me.
- » 46 † Not that any man hath seen the Father, save he which is of God, he hath seen the Father.
- » **47** † Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me hath everlasting life.
- » 48 † I am that bread of life.

JOHN 6:53-66

- » **53** † Then Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except ye eat the flesh of the Son of man, and drink his blood, ye have no life in you.
- **> 54** † Whoso eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, hath eternal life; and I will raise him up at the last day.
- » 55 † For my flesh is meat indeed, and my blood is drink indeed.
- » 56 † He that eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, dwelleth in me, and I in him.
- **>> 57** † As the living Father hath sent me, and I live by the Father: so he that eateth me, even he shall live by me.
- **>> 58** † This is that bread which came down from heaven: not as your fathers did eat manna, and are dead: he that eateth of this bread shall live for ever.
- » 59 † These things said he in the synagogue, as he taught in Capernaum.
- * 60 † ¶ Many therefore of his disciples, when they had heard this, said, This is an hard saying; who can hear it?
- When Jesus knew in himself that his disciples murmured at it, he said unto them, Doth this offend you?
- » 62 † What and if ye shall see the Son of man ascend up where he was before?

- » **63** † It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life.
- » **64** † But there are some of you that believe not. For Jesus knew from the beginning who they were that believed not, and who should betray him.
- **65** † And he said, Therefore said I unto you, that no man can come unto me, except it were given unto him of my Father.
- » 66 † From that time many of his disciples went back, and walked no more with him.

JOHN 7:14-24

- y 14 † ¶ Now about the midst of the feast Jesus went up into the temple, and taught.
- » 15 † And the Jews marvelled, saying, How knoweth this man letters, having never learned?
- » 16 † Jesus answered them, and said, My doctrine is not mine, but his that sent me.
- **To any man will do his will, he shall know of the doctrine, whether it be of God, or whether I speak of myself.**
- **18** † He that speaketh of himself seeketh his own glory: but he that seeketh his glory that sent him, the same is true, and no unrighteousness is in him.
- » 19 † Did not Moses give you the law, and yet none of you keepeth the law? Why go ye about to kill me?
- » 20 † The people answered and said, Thou hast a devil: who goeth about to kill thee?
- » 21 † Jesus answered and said unto them, I have done one work, and ye all marvel.
- » **22** † Moses therefore gave unto you circumcision; (not because it is of Moses, but of the fathers;) and ye on the sabbath day circumcise a man.
- **23** † If a man on the sabbath day receive circumcision, that the law of Moses should not be broken; are ye angry at me, because I have made a man every whit whole on the sabbath day?
- » 24 † Judge not according to the appearance, but judge righteous judgment.

JOHN 7:37-39

- **37** † ¶ In the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink.
- 38 † He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water.
- 39 † (But this spake he of the Spirit, which they that believe on him should receive: for the Holy Ghost was not yet given; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.)

JOHN 8:3-19

- » **3** † And the scribes and Pharisees brought unto him a woman taken in adultery; and when they had set her in the midst,
- * 4 † They say unto him, Master, this woman was taken in adultery, in the very act.
- » 5 † Now Moses in the law commanded us, that such should be stoned: but what sayest thou?
- » **6** † This they said, tempting him, that they might have to accuse him. But Jesus stooped down, and with his finger wrote on the ground, as though he heard them not.
- » **7** † So when they continued asking him, he lifted up himself, and said unto them, He that is without sin among you, let him first cast a stone at her.
- * 8 † And again he stooped down, and wrote on the ground.
- » **9** † And they which heard it, being convicted by their own conscience, went out one by one, beginning at the eldest, even unto the last: and Jesus was left alone, and the woman standing in the midst.
- » **10** † When Jesus had lifted up himself, and saw none but the woman, he said unto her, Woman, where are those thine accusers? hath no man condemned thee?
- » 11 † She said, No man, Lord. And Jesus said unto her, Neither do I condemn thee: go, and sin no more.
- » **12** † ¶ Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.
- The Pharisees therefore said unto him, Thou bearest record of thyself; thy record is not true.
- » **14** † Jesus answered and said unto them, Though I bear record of myself, yet my record is true: for I know whence I came, and whither I go; but ye cannot tell whence I come, and whither I go.
- y 15 † Ye judge after the flesh; I judge no man.
- » 16 † And yet if I judge, my judgment is true: for I am not alone, but I and the Father that sent me.
- * 17 † It is also written in your law, that the testimony of two men is true.
- » 18 † I am one that bear witness of myself, and the Father that sent me beareth witness of me.
- » **19** † Then said they unto him, Where is thy Father? Jesus answered, Ye neither know me, nor my Father: if ye had known me, ye should have known my Father also.

JOHN 8:21-47

- » **21** † ¶ Then said Jesus again unto them, I go my way, and ye shall seek me, and shall die in your sins: whither I go, ye cannot come.
- » 22 † Then said the Jews, Will he kill himself? because he saith, Whither I go, ye cannot come.
- » 23 † And he said unto them, Ye are from beneath; I am from above: ye are of this world; I am not of this world.
- » **24** † I said therefore unto you, that ye shall die in your sins: for if ye believe not that I am he, ye shall die in your sins.
- » **25** † Then said they unto him, Who art thou? And Jesus saith unto them, Even the same that I said unto you from the beginning.
- **26** † I have many things to say and to judge of you: but he that sent me is true; and I speak to the world those things which I have heard of him.
- They understood not that he spake to them of the Father.
- » **28** † Then said Jesus unto them, When ye have lifted up the Son of man, then shall ye know that I am he, and that I do nothing of myself; but as my Father hath taught me, I speak these things.
- **29** † And he that sent me is with me: the Father hath not left me alone; for I do always those things that please him.
- » 30 † As he spake these words, many believed on him.
- » **31** † ¶ Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, If ye continue in my word, then are ye my disciples indeed;
- » 32 † And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.
- » **33** † They answered him, We be Abraham's seed, and were never in bondage to any man: how sayest thou, Ye shall be made free?
- » **34** † Jesus answered them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whosoever committeth sin is the servant of sin.
- » 35 † And the servant abideth not in the house for ever: but the Son abideth ever.
- » 36 † If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed.
- **37** † I know that ye are Abraham's seed; but ye seek to kill me, because my word hath no place in you.
- \gg 38 [†] ¶ I speak that which I have seen with my Father: and ye do that which ye have seen with your father.
- 39 † They answered and said unto him, Abraham is our father. Jesus saith unto them, If ye were Abraham's children, ye would do the works of Abraham.
- **40** † But now ye seek to kill me, a man that hath told you the truth, which I have heard of God: this did not Abraham.
- » **41** † Ye do the deeds of your father. Then said they to him, We be not born of fornication; we have one Father, even God.
- » **42** † Jesus said unto them, If God were your Father, ye would love me: for I proceeded forth and came from God; neither came I of myself, but he sent me.
- » 43 † Why do ye not understand my speech? even because ye cannot hear my word.
- **44** † Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.
- * 45 † And because I tell you the truth, ye believe me not.
- » 46 † ¶ Which of you convinceth me of sin? And if I say the truth, why do ye not believe me?
- » 47 † He that is of God heareth God's words: ye therefore hear them not, because ye are not of God.

JOHN 8:48-59

- **48** † Then answered the Jews, and said unto him, Say we not well that thou art a Samaritan, and hast a devil?
- y 49 † Jesus answered, I have not a devil; but I honour my Father, and ye do dishonour me.
- **>> 50** † And I seek not mine own glory: there is one that seeketh and judgeth.
- » **51** † ¶ Verily, verily, I say unto you, If a man keep my saying, he shall never see death.
- » **52** † Then said the Jews unto him, Now we know that thou hast a devil. Abraham is dead, and the prophets; and thou sayest, If a man keep my saying, he shall never taste of death.
- » **53** † Art thou greater than our father Abraham, which is dead? and the prophets are dead: whom makest thou thyself?
- » **54** † Jesus answered, If I honour myself, my honour is nothing: it is my Father that honoureth me; of whom ye say, that he is your God:

- » **55** † Yet ye have not known him; but I know him: and if I should say, I know him not, I shall be a liar like unto you: but I know him, and keep his saying.
- » **56** † Your father Abraham rejoiced to see my day: and he saw it, and was glad.
- » **57** † Then said the Jews unto him, Thou art not yet fifty years old, and hast thou seen Abraham?
- » 58 † Jesus said unto them, Verily, Verily, I say unto you, Before Abraham was, I am.
- » **59** † Then took they up stones to cast at him: but Jesus hid himself, and went out of the temple, going through the midst of them, and so passed by.
