## **I SAMUEL 8:1-10**

- $\rightarrow$  1  $\uparrow$  ¶ And it came to pass, when Samuel was old, that he made his sons judges over Israel.
- » 2 † Now the name of his firstborn was Joel; and the name of his second, Abiah: they were judges in Beersheba.
- » 3 † And his sons walked not in his ways, but turned aside after lucre, and took bribes, and perverted judgment.
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  4 † ¶ Then all the elders of Israel gathered themselves together, and came to Samuel unto Ramah,
- » 5 † And said unto him, Behold, thou art old, and thy sons walk not in thy ways: now make us a king to judge us like all the nations.
- » 6 † But the thing displeased Samuel, when they said, Give us a king to judge us. And Samuel prayed unto the LORD.
- » 7 † And the LORD said unto Samuel, Hearken unto the voice of the people in all that they say unto thee: for they have not rejected thee, but they have rejected me, that I should not reign over them.
- » 8 † According to all the works which they have done since the day that I brought them up out of Egypt even unto this day, wherewith they have forsaken me, and served other gods, so do they also unto thee.
- » 9 † Now therefore hearken unto their voice: howbeit yet protest solemnly unto them, and shew them the manner of the king that shall reign over them.
- » 10 † And Samuel told all the words of the LORD unto the people that asked of him a king.

#### I SAMUEL 8:18-22

- $\Rightarrow$  18 <sup>†</sup> And ye shall cry out in that day because of your king which ye shall have chosen you; and the LORD will not hear you in that day.
- » 19 † Nevertheless the people refused to obey the voice of Samuel; and they said, Nay; but we will have a king over us;
- » 20 † That we also may be like all the nations; and that our king may judge us, and go out before us, and fight our battles.
- » 21 † And Samuel heard all the words of the people, and he rehearsed them in the ears of the LORD.
- $^{\circ}$  22  $^{\dagger}$  And the LORD said to Samuel, Hearken unto their voice, and make them a king. And Samuel said unto the men of Israel, Go ye every man unto his city.

#### **JEREMIAH 6:16-17**

## **I CORINTHIANS 7:25-28**

- » 32 † But I would have you without carefulness. He that is unmarried careth for the things that belong to the Lord, how he may please the Lord:
- » 33 † But he that is married careth for the things that are of the world, how he may please his wife.
- » 34 † There is difference also between a wife and a virgin. The unmarried woman careth for the things of the Lord, that she may be holy both in body and in spirit: but she that is married careth for the things of the world, how she may please her husband.
- » 35 † And this I speak for your own profit; not that I may cast a snare upon you, but for that which is comely, and that ye may attend upon the Lord without distraction.
