MALACHI 3:8-10

- » 8 † Will a man rob God? Yet ye have robbed me. But ye say, Wherein have we robbed thee? In tithes and offerings.
- » 9 † Ye are cursed with a curse: for ye have robbed me, even this whole nation.
- » 10 † Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the LORD of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it.

GENESIS 14:18-20

- » 18 † And Melchizedek king of Salem brought forth bread and wine: and he was the priest of the most high God.
- » 19 † And he blessed him, and said, Blessed be Abram of the most high God, possessor of heaven and earth:
- 20 † And blessed be the most high God, which hath delivered thine enemies into thy hand. And he gave him tithes of all.

GENESIS 28:16-22

- \Rightarrow 16 † ¶ And Jacob awaked out of his sleep, and he said, Surely the LORD is in this place; and I knew it not.
- » 17 † And he was afraid, and said, How dreadful is this place! this is none other but the house of God, and this is the gate of heaven.
- » 18 † And Jacob rose up early in the morning, and took the stone that he had put for his pillows, and set it up for a pillar, and poured oil upon the top of it.
- » 19 † And he called the name of that place Bethel: but the name of that city was called Luz at the first.
- » 20 † And Jacob vowed a vow, saying, If God will be with me, and will keep me in this way that I go, and will give me bread to eat, and raiment to put on,
- » 21 † So that I come again to my father's house in peace; then shall the LORD be my God:
- » 22 † And this stone, which I have set for a pillar, shall be God's house: and of all that thou shalt give me I will surely give the tenth unto thee.

DEUTERONOMY 8:18

» 18 † But thou shalt remember the LORD thy God: for it is he that giveth thee power to get wealth, that he may establish his covenant which he sware unto thy fathers, as it is this day.

PSALM 24:1-3

- $^{\rm hom}$ 1 $^{\rm hom}$ A Psalm of David. The earth is the LORD'S, and the fulness thereof; the world, and they that dwell therein.
- » 2 † For he hath founded it upon the seas, and established it upon the floods.
- » 3 † ¶ Who shall ascend into the hill of the LORD? or who shall stand in his holy place?

PSALM 50:10-12

- » 10 † For every beast of the forest is mine, and the cattle upon a thousand hills.
- » 11 † I know all the fowls of the mountains: and the wild beasts of the field are mine.

THROUGH TITHE GOD TAKES CARE OF HIS PEOPLE

NUMBERS 18:20-26

- \Rightarrow 20 † ¶ And the LORD spake unto Aaron, Thou shalt have no inheritance in their land, neither shalt thou have any part among them: I am thy part and thine inheritance among the children of Israel.
- » 21 † And, behold, I have given the children of Levi all the tenth in Israel for an inheritance, for their service which they serve, even the service of the tabernacle of the congregation.
- » 22 † Neither must the children of Israel henceforth come night he tabernacle of the congregation, lest they bear sin, and die.
- » 23 † But the Levites shall do the service of the tabernacle of the congregation, and they shall bear their iniquity: it shall be a statute for ever throughout your generations, that among the children of Israel they have no inheritance.
- » 24 † But the tithes of the children of Israel, which they offer as an heave offering unto the LORD, I have given to the Levites to inherit: therefore I have said unto them, Among the children of Israel they shall have no inheritance.
- » 25 † And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying,
- » 26 † Thus speak unto the Levites, and say unto them, When ye take of the children of Israel the tithes which I have given you from them for your inheritance, then ye shall offer up an heave offering of it for the LORD, even a tenth part of the tithe.

LEVITICUS 27:30-33

- » 30 † And all the tithe of the land, whether of the seed of the land, or of the fruit of the tree, is the LORD'S: it is holy unto the LORD.
- » 31 † And if a man will at all redeem ought of his tithes, he shall add thereto the fifth part thereof.
- » 32 † And concerning the tithe of the herd, or of the flock, even of whatsoever passeth under the rod, the tenth shall be holy unto the LORD.
- » 33 † He shall not search whether it be good or bad, neither shall he change it: and if he change it at all, then both it and the change thereof shall be holy; it shall not be redeemed.

DEUTERONOMY 14:22

- » 22 † ¶ Thou shalt truly tithe all the increase of thy seed, that the field bringeth forth year by year.
- » 23 † And thou shalt eat before the LORD thy God, in the place which he shall choose to place his name there, the tithe of thy corn, of thy wine, and of thine oil, and the firstlings of thy herds and of thy flocks; that thou mayest learn to fear the LORD thy God always.

DEUTERONOMY 14:27-29

- » 27 † And the Levite that is within thy gates; thou shalt not forsake him; for he hath no part nor inheritance with thee.
- » 28 † At the end of three years thou shalt bring forth all the tithe of thine increase the same year, and shalt lay it up within thy gates:
- » 29 † And the Levite, (because he hath no part nor inheritance with thee,) and the stranger, and the fatherless, and the widow, which are within thy gates, shall come, and shall eat and be satisfied; that the LORD thy God may bless thee in all the work of thine hand which thou doest.
