- » 1 † The first day of the week cometh Mary Magdalene early, when it was yet dark, unto the sepulchre, and seeth the stone taken away from the sepulchre.

- » 12 † And seeth two angels in white sitting, the one at the head, and the other at the feet, where the body of Jesus had lain.
- » 13 † And they say unto her, Woman, why weepest thou? She saith unto them, Because they have taken away my Lord, and I know not where they have laid him.
- » 14 † And when she had thus said, she turned herself back, and saw Jesus standing, and knew not that it was Jesus.
- » 15 † Jesus saith unto her, Woman, why weepest thou? whom seekest thou? She, supposing him to be the gardener, saith unto him, Sir, if thou have borne him hence, tell me where thou hast laid him, and I will take him away.
