## THE MYSTERY OF INIQUITY

### II THESSALONIANS 2:1-11

» 1 † ¶ Now we beseech you, brethren, by the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, and by our gathering together unto him,

» 2 † That ye be not soon shaken in mind, or be troubled, neither by spirit, nor by word, nor by letter as from us, as that the day of Christ is at hand.

» 3 † ¶ Let no man deceive you by any means: for that day shall not come, except there come a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition;

» 4 † Who opposeth and exalteth himself above all that is called God, or that is worshipped; so that he as God sitteth in the temple of God, shewing himself that he is God.

» 5 † Remember ye not, that, when I was yet with you, I told you these things?

» 6 † And now ye know what withholdeth that he might be revealed in his time.

- » 7 † For the mystery of iniquity doth already work: only he who now letteth will let, until he be taken out of the way.
- » 8 † And then shall that Wicked be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy with the brightness of his coming:
- » 9 † Even him, whose coming is after the working of Satan with all power and signs and lying wonders,
- » 10 † And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved.
- » 11 † And for this cause God shall send them strong delusion, that they should believe a lie:

#### ISAIAH 53:4-6

- » 4 † ¶ Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted.
- » 5 † But he was wounded for our transgressions, **he was bruised for our iniquities**: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.
- » 6 † All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and **the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all.**

#### TITUS 2:11-14

- 11 † ¶ For the grace of God that bringeth salvation hath appeared to all men,
- » 12 † Teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly, in this present world;
- » 13 † Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ;
- » 14 † **Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works.**

#### MICAH 7:17-19

- 17 † They shall lick the dust like a serpent, they shall move out of their holes like worms of the earth: they shall be afraid of the LORD our God, and shall fear because of thee.
- » 18 † Who is a God like unto thee, **that pardoneth iniquity, and passeth by the transgression of the remnant of his heritage? he retaineth not his anger for ever, because he delighteth in mercy.**
- » 19 † **He will turn again, he will have compassion upon us; he will subdue our iniquities; and thou wilt cast all their sins into the depths of the sea.**

#### PSALM 51:1-9

- » 1 † ¶ To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David, when Nathan the prophet came unto him, after he had gone in to Bathsheba. Have mercy upon me, O God, according to thy lovingkindness: according unto the multitude of thy tender mercies blot out my transgressions.
- » 2 † **Wash me thoroughly from mine iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin.**
- » 3 † **For I acknowledge my transgressions: and my sin is ever before me.**
- » 4 † Against thee, thee only, have I sinned, and done this evil in thy sight: that thou mightest be justified when thou speakest, and be clear when thou judgest.
- » 5 † **Behold, I was shapen in iniquity; and in sin did my mother conceive me**
- » 6 † Behold, thou desirest truth in the inward parts: and in the hidden part thou shalt make me to know wisdom.

- » 7 † ¶ Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean: wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow.
- » 8 † Make me to hear joy and gladness; that the bones which thou hast broken may rejoice.
- » 9 † **Hide thy face from my sins, and blot out all mine iniquities.**

**PSALM 32:1-2**

- » 1 † ¶ A Psalm of David, Maschil. Blessed is he whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered.
- » 2 † **Blessed is the man unto whom the LORD imputeth not iniquity, and in whose spirit there is no guile.**

**PSALM 32:5**

- » 5 † I acknowledged my sin unto thee, and **mine iniquity have I not hid.** I said, I will confess my transgressions unto the LORD; and **thou forgavest the iniquity of my sin.** Selah.

**PSALM 119:132-133**

- 132 † ¶ Look thou upon me, and be merciful unto me, as thou usest to do unto those that love thy name.
- » 133 † ¶ Order my steps in thy word: **and let not any iniquity have dominion over me.**

**PROVERBS 16:6**

- » 6 † ¶ **By mercy and truth iniquity is purged: and by the fear of the LORD men depart from evil.**

**ISAIAH 6:5-7**

- » 5 † ¶ Then said I, Woe is me! for I am undone; because I am a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips: for mine eyes have seen the King, the LORD of hosts.
- » 6 † Then flew one of the seraphims unto me, having a live coal in his hand, which he had taken with the tongs from off the altar.
- » 7 † And he laid it upon my mouth, and said, Lo, **this hath touched thy lips; and thine iniquity is taken away, and thy sin purged.**

**DANIEL 9:24**

- » 24 † Seventy weeks are determined upon thy people and upon thy holy city, to finish the transgression, and to make an end of sins, **and to make reconciliation for iniquity,** and to bring in everlasting righteousness, and to seal up the vision and prophecy, and to anoint the most Holy.

**JEREMIAH 31:33-34**

- 33 † But this shall be the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel; After those days, saith the LORD, I will put my law in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts; and will be their God, and they shall be my people.
- » 34 † And they shall teach no more every man his neighbour, and every man his brother, saying, Know the LORD: for they shall all know me, from the least of them unto the greatest of them, saith the LORD: **for I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more.**

**JEREMIAH 33:7-8**

- 7 † And I will cause the captivity of Judah and the captivity of Israel to return, and will build them, as at the first.
- » 8 † And **I will cleanse them from all their iniquity, whereby they have sinned against me; and I will pardon all their iniquities, whereby they have sinned, and whereby they have transgressed against me.**

**JEREMIAH 50:20**

» 20 † In those days, and in that time, saith the LORD, **the iniquity of Israel shall be sought for, and there shall be none; and the sins of Judah, and they shall not be found: for I will pardon them whom I reserve.**

**EZRA 9:5-8**

5 † ¶ And **at the evening sacrifice** I arose up from my heaviness; and having rent my garment and my mantle, I fell upon my knees, and spread out my hands unto the LORD my God,

» 6 † And said, O my God, I am ashamed and blush to lift up my face to thee, my God: **for our iniquities are increased over our head, and our trespass is grown up unto the heavens.**

» 7 † **Since the days of our fathers have we been in a great trespass unto this day; and for our iniquities have we, our kings, and our priests, been delivered into the hand of the kings of the lands, to the sword, to captivity, and to a spoil, and to confusion of face, as it is this day.**

» 8 † **And now for a little space grace hath been shewed from the LORD our God, to leave us a remnant to escape, and to give us a nail in his holy place, that our God may lighten our eyes, and give us a little reviving in our bondage.**

**PSALM 103:1-5**

» 1 † ¶ A Psalm of David. Bless the LORD, O my soul: and all that is within me, bless his holy name.

» 2 † Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits:

» 3 † **Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases;**

» 4 † **Who redeemeth thy life from destruction; who crowneth thee with lovingkindness and tender mercies;**

» 5 † **Who satisfieth thy mouth with good things; so that thy youth is renewed like the eagle's.**
