I PETER 1:18-23

18 ⁺ Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers;

But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot:

» 20 ⁺ Who verily was foreordained before the foundation of the world, but was manifest in these last times for you,

» **21** ⁺ Who by him do believe in God, that raised him up from the dead, and gave him glory; that your faith and hope might be in God.

» **22** ⁺ Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently:

» **23** ⁺ Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever.

» **1** ⁺ **¶** Simon Peter, a servant and an apostle of Jesus Christ, to them that have obtained like precious faith with us through the righteousness of God and our Saviour Jesus Christ:

To further bring out what we have just said, and to also use a Scripture that should be borne in mind as we talk about who it is that is baptized with the Holy Ghost, see what Jesus says in John **6**:**45**,

"It is written in the prophets, And they shall All be taught of God."

But turn to Isaiah 54:13 whence this is taken and it reads,

"And all thy children shall be taught of the Lord."

The ALL of God are the CHILDREN of God. Thus it is that the evidence of being a true child of God, (he whom the Spirit has come upon and in-dwells) is again set forth as one taught the Word by the Holy Ghost.

Now you can begin to see why tongues is not the evidence of being baptized with the Holy Ghost. It doesn't say in any age that "he that hath a tongue let him say what the Spirit is saying." That puts tongues, interpretation thereof, and prophecy, etc. aside as an evidence. The evidence is HEARING what the Spirit says. The Spirit is talking. Yes, the Spirit is teaching. That is exactly what Jesus said He would do when He came.

John 14:26,

"He will teach you all things and bring all things to your remembrance whatsoever I have said unto you."

In every age, (and every age is the age of the Holy Ghost for the true believer)--I say, in every age the evidence was the same. Those who had the Spirit, the Teacher, heard the Word, and that Spirit in them took the Word and taught it (revealed it) to them; and they were of the group that heard the messenger and his message and took it and lived it.

Now we have been constantly saying that the true evidence of being baptized with the Holy Ghost is for the believer to receive the Word for the age in which he lives. Let me show you most clearly.

It's the Holy Spirit that's built that Bride, the Elect that's pulled out of all the organization systems down through the ages, like that. 234 What is the new Birth then? You'd say, "Well, Brother Branham, what is the new Birth?" It is the revelation of Jesus Christ personally to you. Amen! See? Not you joined a church, you shook a hand, you done something different, you said a creed, you promised to live by a--a code of rules. But Christ, the Bible, He is the Word that was revealed to you. Cannot have the Father without the Son; you cannot have the Son without having the Holy Ghost. But you can have the water without the Blood, and the Blood without the Spirit.

47 I think, through our ages, has proved this to be true; water, Blood, Spirit; justification, sanctification, the baptism of the Holy Spirit. That types, or makes the... or, and an antitype, which takes away from the natural birth.

48 **Look when a--a woman or anything in travail, for birth. The first thing comes to pass, the** breaking of the water, a normal birth; second thing is the blood; and then comes life. Water, blood, spirit; and that constitutes the normal, natural birth.

« 49 [†] And so is it in the spiritual realm. It's water; justification by faith, believing on God, receiving Him as your personal Saviour, and being baptized. Second, is sanctification of the spirit, that God cleanses the spirit from all elements of the world, and the desire of the world. And then the Holy Spirit comes in and gives new Birth and fills up that sanctified vessel.

Look at Brother and Sister Kidd here, they're probably the oldest in the building. But if I'd ask them, "What is your heart's desire?" It'd be, "Closer to God." 46 And look here, "Having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust." Escaped it!

And look here, "Having escaped the corruption that is in the world through just." Escaped it! See who it's to? It's to the Church, them who are in Christ, has been exalted above these things. Not he exalted himself, but Christ brought him up.

* 47 ⁺ To my colored brethren and sisters who are present this morning, I don't mean this through any harm. But, was in a meeting some time ago, I don't know whether I ever said it in the tabernacle. I've told it many places. There was a colored sister said, "Can I have a testimony, or testify?"

"Certainly, sister, go right ahead."

48 She said, "I want to make this testimony for the glory of God." She said, "You know, I--I ain't what I ought to be," and she said, "I--I ain't what I want to be, but," she said, "one thing sure, I ain't what I used to be." See? She had come from somewhere. She had been brought up.

[Congregation says, "Amen."--Ed.] The Life of Christ! And the life of any seed... Which, He was the Word Seed, brings the Seed to Life. You get it? Until you're born again, you'll argue against It. If you're just religiously inclined, and--and you got a--a--a little human knowledge that you should do right, you'll never be able to agree upon the Word of God. You'll never do it. You've got to be born again. And, born again, it produces faith. All right. Then, after you get faith, this right here, f-a-i-t-h, faith, then you're just in position of growing.

* 132 [†] Now, a lot of people go up to the altar, and pray, and say, "Lord, forgive me." And a great experience of sanctification come upon them, and things. Then you have a great time, get up to the altar, shouting. You go back, say, "Bless God, I got it." No, you just started to a place where you can grow. You ain't done nothing yet. See? The only thing you done is just laid the foundation.
133 Now you're going to build a house, and you pour the foundation, say, "Boy, I got her." See? You got the foundation to build your house on. Now you got to build a house.

134 Now there's where the thing comes in, this morning, we're going to talk about now. All right. A house, this foundation is first. What is the foundation of Christianity? Faith in the Word of God. That's your foundation. Then you begin to grow. Then you start, you begin to add to this foundation.

* 135 ⁺ Now, building a house, you put your uprights and everything else. Brother Woods, and some of these carpenters and contractors here could tell us how you build your house. See? But I'm going to tell you how to build your spiritual house, where God can dwell. He wants to dwell in you. He wants to make you like Himself. He wants you to be reflected, reflecting, rather, His Being.

* 136 ⁺ You know, in the old time when they used to make gold, before they had the smelter to burn it out, they used to beat the gold out, beat the sludge out, the iron and copper and stuff, out, and just keep beating, and turn it over, and beating it. The Indians do that now, beating gold, and they beat it. You know how they could tell all the iron was out of it, and all the dirt and stuff, and the dross was out of it? When the one that was beating could see his own reflection, like a mirror, in it. It was clean and clear enough till it reflected the beater.

137 That's the way God does. He takes the gold that He has found in the earth, and He beats it, by the Holy Spirit, turn it over, and over, and over, and beating it until (He receives) He can see His reflection. [Brother Branham clapped his hands several times throughout this sentence--Ed.]

138 + And that's what we're supposed to do, reflect the Son of God. And now we're supposed to do His work. He said, "He that believeth on Me..." Saint John 14:7, "He that believeth on Me, the works that I do shall he do also." You're beginning to reflect the works of Christ.

139 But so many of us try to do the works of Christ before the reflection of Christ is in us. <mark>Now</mark> there's the trouble. We find those things happening. You know it. I know it. We see these, stumbles along the road. We find the scrap heap of ministers, of Christians, piled along the road, is because they didn't go into it right.

140 And that's why I'm here this morning, is to try to teach this little church, and myself, how that we can become the dwelling place of the living God. How many like to be that? [Congregation says, "Amen."--Ed.] The dwelling place of the living God!

« 141 [†] Now here is what we do. What's the first thing? Have faith, and be born again. That's laying the foundation.

142 Then, after we lay the foundation, secondly you add to your foundation. "Add to your faith," Peter said here. Add to your... First you have faith, then you add virtue to your faith. This is the next column. First, pour your foundation, faith. Then, to your faith, add virtue.

143 Now, right there knocks a lot of us down. Yes, sir. Yes. "Add virtue to your faith." That doesn't just mean living a virgin life, you know, like the woman or a man, and so forth. That doesn't have nothing to do with that.
