## 18-0624am - Being Born Again Pt.20 (A Tabernacle for God) - Samuel Dale

### I PETER 1:22-23

- » **22** † Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently:
- » **23** † Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever.

### HEBREWS 10:1-5

- » **1** † ¶ For the law having a shadow of good things to come, and not the very image of the things, can never with those sacrifices which they offered year by year continually make the comers thereunto perfect.
- » **2** † For then would they not have ceased to be offered? because that the worshippers once purged should have had no more conscience of sins.
- » **3** † But in those sacrifices there is a remembrance again made of sins every year.
- » **4** † For it is not possible that the blood of bulls and of goats should take away sins.
- » **5** † Wherefore when he cometh into the world, he saith, Sacrifice and offering thou wouldest not, but a body hast thou prepared me:

### 2A) 65-1204 THE.RAPTURE\_ YUMA.AZ V-5 N-14 SATURDAY\_

- « **144** † You say, "I got the baptism, the Holy Ghost." That don't mean that you're saved, not by a long ways.

**145** Looky here. You are a triune being. You are. Inside this little fellow here is the soul, the next is the spirit, and next is the body. Now, you got five senses in this body, to contact your earthly home. They don't contact the rest of it. You got five senses of the spirit, here: love and conscience, and so forth, of that. But in here is where you live. **That's what you are.**

### 1) ACTS 7:44-50

- » **44** † Our fathers had the tabernacle of witness in the wilderness, as he had appointed, speaking unto Moses, that **he should make it according to the fashion that he had seen.**
- » **45** † Which also our fathers that came after brought in with Jesus into the possession of the Gentiles, whom God drave out before the face of our fathers, unto the days of David;
- » **46** † Who found favour before God, and desired to find a tabernacle for the God of Jacob.
- » **47** † **But Solomon built him an house.**
- » **48** † **Howbeit the most High dwelleth not in temples made with hands; as saith the prophet,**
- » **49** † Heaven is my throne, and earth is my footstool: what house will ye build me? saith the Lord: or what is the place of my rest?
- » **50** † Hath not my hand made all these things?

### 2) MATTHEW 3:13-17

- » **13** † ¶ Then cometh Jesus from Galilee to Jordan unto John, to be baptized of him.
- » **14** † But John forbad him, saying, I have need to be baptized of thee, and comest thou to me?
- » **15** † And Jesus answering said unto him, Suffer it to be so now: for thus it becometh us to fulfil all righteousness. Then he suffered him.
- » **16** † And Jesus, when he was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and, lo, the heavens were opened unto him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove, and lighting upon him:
- » **17** † And lo a voice from heaven, saying, This is my beloved Son, **in whom I am well pleased.**

### 3) MATTHEW 17:4-5

- » **4** † Then answered Peter, and said unto Jesus, Lord, it is good for us to be here: if thou wilt, **let us make here three tabernacles;** one for thee, and one for Moses, and one for Elias.
- » **5** † While he yet spake, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them: and behold a voice out of the cloud, which said, **This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased; hear ye him.**

**4) 62-0218 PERSEVERANCE\_ JEFFERSONVILLE.IN V-10 N-3 SUNDAY\_**

« 30 † Christ, when He was on earth, was the body of God. God created this body. **It was a different body,** yet it was a human body. You know, Solomon built Him a house. But Stephen said, "Howbeit the Most High don't dwell in houses made with hands, but a body has Thou prepared Me." Now, God prepared Himself a body in the form of the Lord Jesus, which was the Christ, meaning the anointed One. And, now, all that God was, was in Christ, He was the fulness of the godhead bodily. That's what the Scripture says. Now, and all that God was, He poured out in Christ. He was **Immanuel, God with us!**

**31** And all that Christ was, He poured out into the Church. What is it? Anointed one, to continue His work that His Word might live constantly. He lived by the Word of the Father. "Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every Word that proceedeth from the mouth of God." And the Church don't live by bread alone, but by the Word of Christ. And the Holy Spirit comes in and takes the Word of Christ and makes It a living action today. "These signs shall follow them that believe."

« 81 † Oh, how we see Him in David! How David, a rejected king, threw off his own throne, by his brethren, his own son, sit upon the Mount of Olives, as he went up, top of the Mount of Olives, looked back over at Jerusalem and cried; for there his own people, that he had served them and taught them of God, and his own people turned him off and throwed things at him, spit on him and made fun, when he started up the hill and was rejected. Oh, how perfect of the Son of God, eight hundred years later; a rejected King, among His Own people, sit on the mount and wept over Jerusalem, as a rejected King.

**82** **What was it? God reflecting Himself in those prophets, reflecting Christ.**

**83** **Then there came One which was the perfection of God. It was God among us.**

**84** **And since that time, He has reflected Himself in His Church, this side of Calvary. So, you see, we're all trying to get to this dwelling place, Tabernacle of the living God. Now there's some people...**

**6) 62-1014M THE.STATURE.OF.A.PERFECT.MAN\_ JEFFERSONVILLE.IN V-2 N-18 SUNDAY\_**

« 68 † Now in the... Now, **"tabernacle," is, course, a place where we go to rest, now, get freshness, and so forth, like resting from sleep, or so forth. Now, Hebrews 10, and the 5th verse, Paul brings it in.**

*Wherefore when he cometh into the world, he saith, Sacrifice... (That's Christ.)... Sacrifice and offering thou wouldest not, but a body hast thou prepared me:*

**69** **What is the Tabernacle now? A Body, God tabernacling in a Body.**

**70** God once, up high, when He come down on the mountain, even if a--a bullock or a cow touched the mountain, he must be killed. God is holy.

**71** Last evening, when those Angels covered Their faces. Holy Seraphims with holy faces, don't even know what sin means, and They have to cover Their face, in the Presence of God; cover Their feet, in humility.

**72** Now, holy God could not condone sin, so nothing could touch the mountain where God was.

**73** **Then God was made flesh and dwelt among us, in the form of Jesus Christ, His Son, His creation.** Then that Son gave His life, and the Blood cell of God was broken, that the Life might come out of the Blood, to us.

**74** Through that Blood we are cleansed. And now our blood, our life, which came by living through sexual desire, brought our life in the world. **The Blood of Jesus Christ cleanses us, changes our nature, by sending upon us the Holy Spirit; then we become into the Divine nature of God, then we become a dwelling place for God.** Jesus said, "At that day you'll know that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me; I in you, and you in Me." See?

« 75 † **Know how that God is in His Church. The Church is now supposed to be taking the place of Christ, carrying on His ministry.** "He that believeth on Me, the works that I do shall he do also. Yet a little while, and the world seeth Me no more; yet you shall see Me, for I will be with you, even in you, to the end of the world." See? There it is, carrying on His work.

**7) 53-1130 HAS.THE.LORD.SPOKEN.ONLY.TO.MOSES\_ WEST.PALM.BEACH.FL MONDAY\_**

« E-69 † You believe with all your heart? You brought your baby here for one thing. She's mighty sweet. I've got a little one at home like that tonight, about that age. Do you believe that God can reveal to me that baby? Do you believe that God will hear my prayer? And now, if Jesus was here on earth in a body of flesh, you'd go to Him. Certainly, you would. You'd take your baby there. Well then, 'course, He's--He's--His body has been received up into heaven but His Spirit is here, **and we are His Body now, and that's the reason you brought her to me.**

**8) < 315-4 † PHILADELPHIAN.CHURCH.AGE - CHURCH.AGE.BOOK CPT.8**

Now He is not only giving crowns but He says that these in the bride will be made pillars in the temple of God. **But what is the temple of God? Jesus spoke of His body as being the temple. It was. It was the temple of God. But now that we are His body, the true church is the temple of God by the Holy Ghost within us.** Now He is going to make the overcomer a pillar in that temple. But what is a pillar? A pillar is actually a part of the foundation for it holds up the superstructure. Praise God, that puts the overcomer right in with the apostles and prophets, for it says in Ephesians 2:19-22,

**9) 53-1018 ELIJAH\_ LOUISVILLE.KY SUNDAY\_**

< **E-22** † Look at this man--this man, Elijah, he said, "Send down the drought." And he closed off the heavens that it didn't rain. And now, I want you to, just, to notice now, just for a prefigure what taken place here. Now, when God told Elijah to go do this, and he went down and predicted to the people what was going to happen, well, those people, no doubt, said, "Well, that man's crazy." Now, if you could've seen him come up, he wasn't a great diplomatic looking man. He had an old piece of sheepskin wrapped around him like this, and his beard sticking all out over his face, and hair probably hanging out the same way. And he walked down the street, little old skinny, boney body with a oil cruse hanging on his side and a stick in his hand, walking down the street; but God was with him.

That's what's the matter today, brother. We have went to the big church or some brethren say, "Oh, well, our church looks better than yours. And ours does this, that, or the other." You're looking at the outside. What does it make any difference there? What kind of a people has it got in it? Has it got a people there who loves God, prays to God, worships, a prayer meeting, and so forth? You'll see a prospering church when you see that kind of a people. **Yes, sir, not the building. God said, "Sacrifices and so forth," said, "I have none. And Solomon built Him a house. But howbeit the most High dwelleth not in houses made by hands for He said, Heaven is My throne and earth is My footstool: and where is the house of My rest? But a heart has Thou prepared me, a body." God comes to the individual.**

< **4** † I was wondering where you was at, Anthony. I see you met your father. And I looked across, out in the audience. He said you was sitting there. We happy to have you and your father here with us, Brother Milano from New York. Hoping, going overseas this time, I get another spring-off, out of New York, out there somewhere, if the Lord willing.

**5** And so we are very happy for every one of you. Just--just fine for you to be here.

**6** And we had a great time last night, or at least I did. I had a... [Congregation says, "Amen."--Ed.] "And Isaiah in the temple." And so you...

**7** **And this morning, we want to speak on the subject, or teach, rather, if we can, "Building the living Tabernacle; building the--building the living Tabernacle of the living God's dwelling place, the perfect Man; the living Tabernacle of the living God, where He dwells." And if...**

< **138** † And that's what we're supposed to do, reflect the Son of God. And now we're supposed to do His work. He said, "He that believeth on Me..." Saint John **14:7**, "He that believeth on Me, the works that I do shall he do also." You're beginning to reflect the works of Christ.

**139** But so many of us try to do the works of Christ before the reflection of Christ is in us. Now there's the trouble. We find those things happening. You know it. I know it. We see these, stumbles along the road. We find the scrap heap of ministers, of Christians, piled along the road, is because they didn't go into it right.

**140** **And that's why I'm here this morning, is to try to teach this little church, and myself, how that we can become the dwelling place of the living God. How many like to be that? [Congregation says, "Amen."--Ed.] The dwelling place of the living God!**

< **341** † These fellows wasn't required what these fellows are. This wasn't required what this was. See? But He brought His Church up the same way. He brought His--His Church up the same way He's bringing His people up. Then Peter here says, first, seven things: faith, virtue, (see, come up), knowledge, temperance, patience, godliness, brotherly love, add brotherly kindness, and then the love of God. The Holy Ghost, **Christ in the person of the Holy Ghost, comes upon you, in the true baptism of the Holy Ghost, and you got all these virtues sealed in you. Then, God lives in a Tabernacle, called the Building, the living Tabernacle of the living God's dwelling place.**

« 346 † Now, that is the House that God dwells in; not a building with a big bell on top of it, and a high steeple. See? "But a Body has Thou prepared Me," a Body that God can dwell in, God can walk in, God can see in, God can talk in, God can work in. Amen! **Living instrumentality of God, God walking on two feet, in you. Glory! "The footsteps of the righteous is ordered of God," God walking in you. "For ye are written epistles, read of all men." And if the Life that's in Christ be in you, you'll bear the Life that Christ bore.**

**13) 62-1014M THE.STATURE.OF.A.PERFECT.MAN\_ JEFFERSONVILLE.IN V-2 N-18 SUNDAY\_**

« 361 † **Then the Word, coming from Here, manifests Itself through each one of these beings, see, and makes this complete Being a Tabernacle of the living God, a walking, living example of Christianity. What Christ was, these people are, because His Life is in here. They are in Christ. And their life is dead and hid in Christ, through God, and sealed in there by the Holy Ghost.** First Corinthians 12. That's right. See? You reckon yourself dead, then you're born of faith. Then virtue and these other things is added to you till you're a perfect, living image of God. That wonderful? [Congregation says, "Amen."--Ed.]

**14) HAGGAI 2:9**

» 9 † **The glory of this latter house shall be greater than of the former, saith the LORD of hosts: and in this place will I give peace, saith the LORD of hosts.**
