20-0916 - When The Word Sees The Word Pt.2 (Abiding In The Wisdom Of God) - Luis Urrego

I CORINTHIANS 2:1-16

1 And I, brethren, when I came to you, came not with excellency of speech or of wisdom, declaring unto you the testimony of God.

2 For I determined not to know any thing among you, save Jesus Christ, and him crucified.

3 And I was with you in weakness, and in fear, and in much trembling.

4 And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power:

5 That your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God.

6 Howbeit we speak wisdom among them that are perfect: yet not the wisdom of this world, nor of the princes of this world, that come to nought:

<mark>7 But we speak <u>the wisdom of God in a mystery, even the hidden wisdom, which God ordained</u> before the world unto our glory:</mark>

<mark>8 Which none of the princes of this world knew: <u>for had they known it, they would not have</u> crucified the Lord of glory.</mark>

9 But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, <mark>the</mark> <mark>things which God hath prepared for them that love him.</mark>

10 <u>But God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit:</u> for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God.

11 For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? even so the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God.

12 Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, **but the spirit which is of God; <u>that we might</u> know the things that are freely given to us of God.**

13 Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual.

14But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.

15 But he that is spiritual judgeth all things, yet he himself is judged of no man.

16 For who hath known the mind of the Lord, that he may instruct him? But we have the mind of Christ.

SMYRNAEAN.CHURCH.AGE - CHURCH.AGE.BOOK CPT.4

Down through the centuries we could go. We find a Moses, a Jeremiah, a John the Baptist, and each one of these were God's eternal thought expressed in its season. Then we come to Jesus the LOGOS. He was the perfect and complete THOUGHT expressed and He became known as the Word. That is what He IS, and forever WILL BE.

Now it says that "He hath chosen us IN HIM (Jesus) before the foundation of the world." That means that we were right there WITH Him in the mind and thoughts of God before the foundation of the world. <u>That</u> gives an ETERNAL quality to the elect. You can't get away from that.

3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ:

4 According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love:

5 Having **predestinated us** unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will,

JAMES 3:13-18

13 Who is a wise man and endued with knowledge among you? let him shew out of a good conversation his works with **meekness of wisdom.**

14 But if ye have bitter envying and strife in your hearts, glory not, and lie not against the truth.

15 **This wisdom descendeth not from above**, but is earthly, sensual, devilish.

16 For where envying and strife is, there is confusion and every evil work.

1<mark>7 <u>But the wisdom that is from above</u> is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, and easy to be intreated, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy.</mark>

18 And the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace of them that make peace.

Galatians 5:22

22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, 23Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law.

90 And the only way that we can ever live is because we have Eternal Life. This body dies, all of our parts die. But the part that's Eternal is God, and cannot die. Now, now, the Word, the Bible, is Eternal, because It is God in Word form. And what was in God, in His thoughts, before there was any spoken Word, it was God. You see it? [Congregation says, "Amen."—Ed.] It was God. Therefore, being predestinated, we who are; saying "we," trusting I'm along with you that was predestinated; was the —the things that was with God in Eternity.

91 And then, if you are a born-again child of God, you are, and got the Holy Spirit in you, you are the manifestations of God's spoken Word before It was a Word. It has to be a thought before it can be a Word. A Word is a spoken thought. And the thoughts was in God, and then we were in God in Eternity, and we were spoken into existence by the Word. Oh, what a...By what Word? This Word, God's Word.
