JOB 14:12-15

Resurrection is a state of having passed completely through death and having risen from death. To be in resurrection is different than to be alive. To be alive is the original state without having passed through death. To be in resurrection is to have passed through death and to have been raised up.

I CORINTHIANS 15:12-14

- » 12 † ¶ Now if Christ be preached that he rose from the dead, how say some among you that there is no resurrection of the dead?
- » 13 † But if there be no resurrection of the dead, then is Christ not risen:
- » 14 † And if Christ be not risen, then is our preaching vain, and your faith is also vain.

I CORINTHIANS 15:20-23

- \gg 20 [†] ¶ But now is Christ risen from the dead, and become the firstfruits of them that slept.
- » 21 † For since by man came death, by man came also the resurrection of the dead.
- » 22 † For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive.
