- » 10 † And then shall many be offended, and shall betray one another, and shall hate one another.

- » 13 † But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved.

WHAT IS INIQUITY?

Gross immorality or injustice; wickedness.

A grossly immoral act; a sin.

Lack of equity; **gross** injustice; unrighteousness; wickedness:

"the condition of one without law," "lawlessness"

1. Hypocrisy

62-0318 - "THE SPOKEN WORD IS THE ORIGINAL SEED"

What is iniquity? Something that you know that's wrong, and you do it, anyhow. And you know that God's Word is right. Why do you play the hypocrite? Because of your organization, and pick a little bit here and won't take the rest of It. You worker of iniquity!

2. Blatant Disobedience

65-1031M - "POWER OF TRANSFORMATION"

» 171 † Iniquity is something that you know that you ought to do and you won't do it. You know better, but won't do it. It's iniquity, see. You know they should stay with the Word of God, but for the church sake, or somebody else's sake, or something else, you'll stray from the Word of God and do what the organization says. "Well, I don't know. My church says we should do it this way, and I believe it this way."

3. Pride And Self-Centeredness

64-0315 - "INFLUENCE"

221 Iniquity, what is iniquity? Iniquity is something that you know it's wrong, and still holding to it. When you know your creeds are wrong, and you still hold to it, that's iniquity.

Begins In The Heart Before It Manifests Outwardly

64-1212 - "THE HARVEST TIME"

216 What is iniquity? It's something that you know that's right, and you concede it and won't do it, **in your heart.** When you know that that Bible teaches a certain thing, and you won't do it, that's iniquity. And David said, "If I hide iniquity in my heart, God will not even hear my prayer."

The Love Of Many Shall Wax Cold

Matthew:24:12

» 12 † And because <u>iniquity</u> shall abound, <u>the love of many shall wax cold.</u>

Four Observations Of This Verse

- Iniquity Will Be Abundant (PLENTY OF INIQUITY)
- The Love Will Dwindle (Not Completely Go Away)
- The Love Of Many (NOT ALL) Will Dwindle
- The Love Described Here Is Agape Love

Agape Love - Noun Feminine

Bro. Branham Speaking Of Love Waxing Cold

50-0716 - "BELIEVEST THOU THIS?"

47 Used to be, a long time ago, when the neighbor got sick or something, we went over and cut his corn, cut him some wood if it was wintertime. And today the neighbor can die, and you don't know it till you read it in the paper. That's right. **No friendship among one another any more. That's awful.**

Love... "Because the iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold," said Jesus in Matthew's the 24th chapter. That's true.

51-0729A - "THE RESURRECTION OF LAZARUS"

50 A long time ago when we used to run out of money, we'd go over to the neighbor and borrow fifty dollars to hold us over. Why, we didn't have to sign any notes. **We trusted one another.** You can't borrow five dollars now without a ten dollar security on top of it. That's right. **No love...**

6But when he came to Simon Peter, this disciple asked, "Lord, are you going to wash my feet?"

7Jesus answered, "You don't really know what I am doing, but later you will understand."

8"You will never wash my feet!" Peter replied. "If I don't wash you," Jesus told him, "you don't really belong to me."

9Peter said, "Lord, don't wash just my feet. Wash my hands and my head."

10Jesus answered, "People who have bathed and are clean all over need to wash just their feet. And you, my disciples, are clean, except for one of you."

- 11Jesus knew who would betray him. That is why he said, "except for one of you."
