32 Moses went forward, packing a stick. And we find out the Red Sea opened, 'cause a mighty wind followed that Fire, the Light of God. When man walks in the Light, then the winds follow. Jesus said, "Tarry ye in the city of Jerusalem until you're endued with power from on high." And they waited until there come from heaven a sound of a rushing mighty wind. They walked in Light, till the wind begin to blow. Amen. Just step in the Light tonight, you outside of Christ; the winds will come back again like they was on the day of Pentecost. Just keep walking in the Light; it'll separate the thing that was hindering you from one side to the other.

Notice, the children of Israel walked across the Red Sea, not only in the mud, they were on dry ground—walking light. That's the trouble with the church today: You're so loaded down you can't walk light. Got too many things on you, too much hanging around. Paul said, "Let us lay aside every weight (that we might walk light)—every weight, and the sin doth easily beset us, that we might run with patience the race that's set before us, looking to the Author and Finisher," Christ.

Principle 5: Avoid debt like a curse. The blessing of the LORD, it maketh rich, and he addeth no sorrow with it.. Prov 10:22


Principle 6: "Winter is coming" Save a little! PROVERBS 6:6-11 "Go to the ant"
