And now, as the theologians call it, a theophany went from That, which was called, in the Scriptural, the "Logos," the Logos that went out of God. It's hard to explain, but It was a part of God. Now, here is what happened. Oh, excuse me. I--I--I just get on this, this just gets me right where I love it. See? The Logos, and this great Fountain, this great Fountain of Spirit which had no beginning or no end; this great Spirit began to form, in the creation, and the Logos that went out from It was the Son of God. It was the only visible form that the Spirit had. And It was a theophany, which means a body, and the body was like a man.

- It didn't have ears like you hear, but a far more hearing. See?
- It was a Theophany, that all this rainbow condescended into a--a Theophany.
- Moses saw It when It passed through the rock like that. He saw the back parts, said, "It looked like a man."
- Abraham saw Him when He stepped down into human flesh and eat a calf, drank some milk, eat the butter. Abraham saw Him as He just stepped in, and then vanished right away from it.
