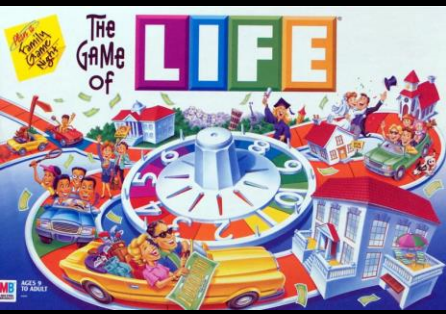




Financial Jubilee 4: Contentment

21 "And that's the way it is with human life. You can't play the rules of the game of life wrong and expect to win. You've got to play it according to God's Word and the purpose that you were brought here for.

GOD's Principles & Standards

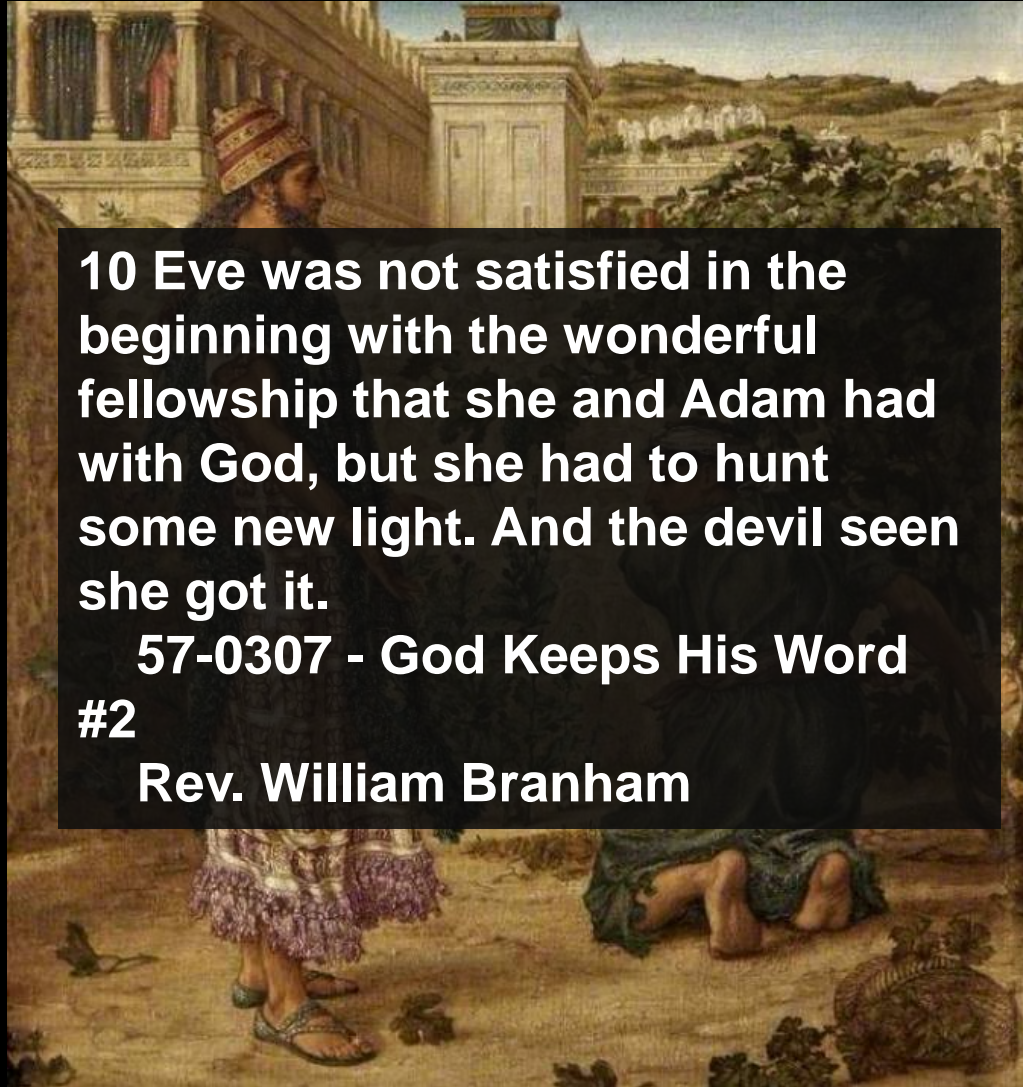
