
Hebrews 10:1

HEBREWS 8:1-2

Now of the things which we have spoken this is the sum: We have such an high priest, who is set on the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in the heavens;
A minister of the sanctuary, and of the true tabernacle, which the Lord pitched, and not man.

HEBREWS 9:24

» 24 † For Christ is not entered into the holy places made with hands, which are the figures of the true; but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us:



EXODUS 25:40

» 38 † And the tongs thereof, and the snuffdishes thereof, shall be of pure gold.

» 39 † Of a talent of pure gold shall he make it, with all these vessels.

» 40 † And look that thou make them after their pattern, which was shewed thee in the mount.

HEBREWS 8:3-4

- » 3 † For every high priest is ordained to offer gifts and sacrifices: wherefore it is of necessity that this man have somewhat also to offer.
- » 4 † For if he were on earth, he should not be a priest, seeing that there are priests that offer gifts according to the law:
- » 5 † Who serve unto the example and shadow of heavenly things, as Moses was admonished of God when he was about to make the tabernacle: for, See, saith he, that thou make all things according to the pattern shewed to thee in the mount.

HEBREWS 8:6-7

- » 6 † But now hath he obtained a more excellent ministry, by how much also he is the mediator of a better covenant, which was established upon better promises.
 » 7 † For if that first covenant had been faultless,
- » / † For it that first covenant had been faultless, then should no place have been sought for the second.
- » 8 † For finding fault with them, he saith, Behold, the days come, saith the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah:

which my covenant they brake, although I was an husband unto them, saith
the LORD:

9 † Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day when I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt; because they continued not in my covenant, and I regarded them not, saith the Lord.
 » 10 † For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after


those days, saith the Lord; I will put my laws into their mind, and write them in

their hearts: and I will be to them a God, and they shall be to me a people:

» 11 † And they shall not teach every man his neighbour, and every man his brother, saying, Know the Lord: for all shall know me, from the least to the greatest.

» 12 † For I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their iniquities will I remember no more.

- 57-0922E HEBREWS.CHAPTER.SEVEN.2_ JEFFERSONVILLE.IN HEB SUNDAY_
- « 366 † You can't, no matter what you do. You quit drinking, quit smoking, quit telling lies, go to church and try to do this and try to do that, you're still carnal. That's just law. The law makes nothing perfect. But what makes perfect? Christ. Glory!
- I might quit lying, quit stealing, quit committing adultery, quit chewing, quit all the things, and I'm still carnal.
- God don't receive it, because I have nothing to offer Him in propitiation.
- 367 But the minute that I lay my hands upon the blessed head of the Lord Jesus, and say, "Lord, I'm no good. Will You take me as Your servant?" and God kisses away my sin, I stand perfect in the sight of God. That's right. Why?
- I'm not standing on my own merit. I'm standing on His.
- And He has perfected us, through His suffering and His Blood.



HEBREWS 8:13

- » 13 † In that he saith, A new covenant, he hath made the first old. Now that which decayeth and waxeth old is ready to vanish away.
 - Christ's sacrifice met every requirement of the Law.
 If you are in Christ, every requirement has already been met.
 - The Life of Christ in the Believer will be a living manifestation of the essence of the Law

MARK 12:29

- » 29 † And Jesus answered him, **The first of all the commandments is**, Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God is one Lord:
- » 30 † And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this is the first commandment.
- » 31 † And the second is like, namely this, **Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.** There is none other commandment greater than these.

ROMANS 8:3-9 3 † For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned

- sin in the flesh:

 » 4 † That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.
- For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit.
 For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life
- and peace.

 » 7 † Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be.
- 8 † So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God.
 9 † But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of
- God dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his.

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ROMANS 13:8
            Owe no man any thing, but to love one another: for he that
loveth another hath fulfilled the law.
            For this, Thou shalt not commit adultery, Thou shalt not kill,
Thou shalt not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness, Thou shalt not
covet; and if there be any other commandment, it is briefly
comprehended in this saying, namely, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as
thyself.



- God has a law, and that law is love. God can't work against Himself.

HEBREWS 9:1-2

- » 1 † Then verily the first covenant had also ordinances of divine service, and a worldly sanctuary.
- » 2 † For there was a tabernacle made; the first, wherein was the candlestick, and the table, and the shewbread; which is called the sanctuary.



Hebrews 9:3-5

- » 3 † And after the second veil, the tabernacle which is called the Holiest of all;
- » 4 † Which had the golden censer, and the ark of the covenant overlaid round about with gold, wherein was the golden pot that had manna, and Aaron's rod that budded, and the tables of the covenant;
- » 5 † And over it the cherubims of glory shadowing the mercyseat; of which we cannot now speak particularly.



THE HOLY GHOST

HEBREWS 9:6-8

- » 6 † Now when these things were thus ordained, the priests went always into the first tabernacle, accomplishing the service of God.
- » 7 † But into the second went the high priest alone once every year, not without blood, which he offered for himself, and for the errors of the people:
- » 8 † The Holy Ghost this signifying, that the way into the holiest of all was not yet made manifest, while as the first tabernacle was yet standing:
- » 9 † Which was a figure for the time then present, in which were offered both gifts and sacrifices, that could not make him that did the service perfect, as

pertaining to the conscience;

» 10 † Which stood only in meats and drinks, and divers washings, and carnal ordinances, imposed on them until the time of reformation.

HEBREWS 9:11-12

- » 11 † But Christ being come an high priest of good things to come, by a greater and more perfect tabernacle, not made with hands, that is to say, not of this building;
- » 12 † Neither by the blood of goats and calves, **but by his own blood he entered in once into the holy place**, having obtained eternal redemption for us.

MARK 7:6-9

» 7 † Howbeit in vain do they worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men.

8 † For laying aside the commandment of God, ye hold the tradition of men, as the washing of pots and cups: and many other such like things ye do.
 9 † And he said unto them, Full well ye reject the commandment of

God, that ye may keep your own tradition.

HEBREWS 9:13-14

MATTHEW 23:25-28 † Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye make clean the outside of the cup and of the platter, but within they are full of

extortion and excess. 26 † Thou blind Pharisee, cleanse first that which is within the cup and platter, that the outside of them may be clean also.

Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for **ye are like** unto whited sepulchres, which indeed appear beautiful outward, but are within full of dead men's bones, and of all uncleanness. Even so ye also outwardly appear righteous unto men, but

within ye are full of hypocrisy and iniquity.

HEBREWS 9:13-14

- » 13 † For if the blood of bulls and of goats, and the ashes of an heifer sprinkling the unclean, sanctifieth to the purifying of the flesh:
- » 14 † How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from **dead works** to serve the living God?

EPHESIANS 2:8-11

- » 8 † For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God:
- » 9 † Not of works, lest any man should boast.
- » 10 † For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.

HEBREWS 9:13-14

Works are a RESULT of Salvation, NOT ITS CAUSE

James 2:18-22

- » 18 † Yea, a man may say, Thou hast faith, and I have works: shew me thy faith without thy works, and I will shew thee my faith by my works.
- » 19 † Thou believest that there is one God; thou doest well: the devils also believe, and tremble.
- » 20 † But wilt thou know, O vain man, that faith without works is dead?
- » 21 † Was not Abraham our father justified by works, when he had offered Isaac his son upon the altar?
- » 22 † Seest thou how faith wrought with his works, and by works was faith made perfect?

HEBREWS 9:15-17

» 15 † And for this cause he is the mediator of the new testament, that **by means of death**, for the redemption of the transgressions that were under the first testament, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance.

- » 16 † For where a testament is, there must also of necessity be the death of the testator.
- » 17 † For a testament is of force **after men are dead:** otherwise it is of no strength at all while the testator liveth.

HEBREWS 9:18-20

» 18 † Whereupon neither the first testament was dedicated without blood.

> 19 † For when Moses had spoken every precept to all the people according to the law, he took the blood of calves and of goats, with water, and scarlet wool, and hyssop, and sprinkled both the book, and all the people,
> 20 † Saying, This is the blood of the


testament which God hath enjoined unto

you.




EXODUS 24:8

23 † It was therefore necessary that the patterns of things in the heavens should be purified with these; but the heavenly things themselves with better sacrifices than these.
 24 † For Christ is not entered into the holy places made with hands, which are the figures of the true; but into heaven itself, now to appear in the

HFBRFWS 9:23-28

which are the figures of the true; but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us:

» 25 † Nor yet that he should offer himself often, as the high priest entereth into the holy place every year with blood of others;

» 26 † For then must he often have suffered since the foundation of the world: but now once in the end of the world hath he appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of himself.

» 27 † And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:

» 28 † So Christ was once offered to bear the sins of many; and unto them that look for him shall he appear the second time without sin unto salvation.
