- **God has a law, and that law is love.** God can't work against Himself.
- Then **if I love God correctly, then I'm going to testify the Truth about God, if I'm in love with Him.**
- I've got a wife's here in this building. God knows how I love her.
- Well, you know, everything good, and everything, it's going to be for my wife. You know that. Sure. Just like your husband would be, to you.
- Well now, **if we love** God, then my confidence becomes perfect in Him, **as I love** Him.
- **Now, He can't break that law of love, see, because it's in my heart.**

Legalism?

- **Legalism** is the conviction that law-keeping is now, after the fall, the ground of our acceptance with God.
- ***How can I get God to be for me and not against me?***
The legalist answer is “Keep the law. Perform the law.”

Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by faith without the deeds of the law.
Romans 3:28

- Legalism is a failure to be humbled, broken, amazed, and satisfied by the grace of God in Christ.

Legalism?

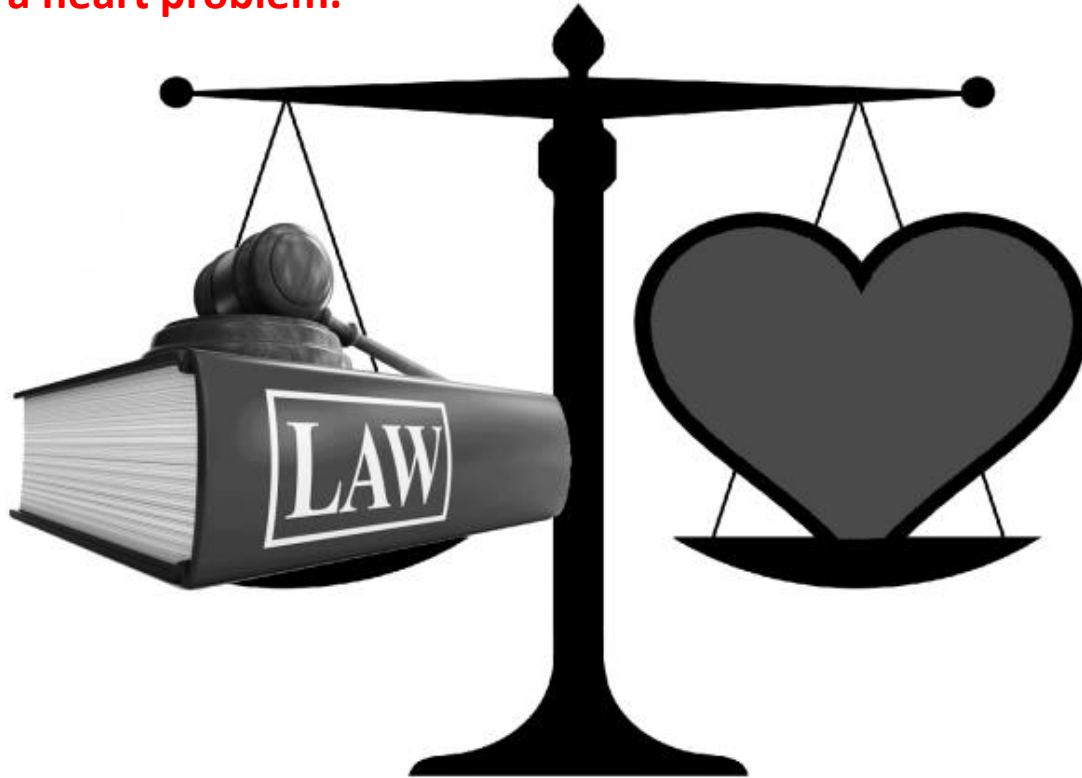
- **Legalism** is comparing with others rather than looking to God.

Luke 18:11-14

- » 11 † *The Pharisee stood and prayed thus with himself, God, **I thank thee, that I am not as other men are**, extortioners, unjust, adulterers, **or even as this publican.***
- » 12 † *I fast twice in the week, I give tithes of all that I possess.*
- » 13 † *And the publican, standing afar off, would not lift up so much as his eyes unto heaven, but smote upon his breast, saying, God be merciful to me a sinner.*
- » 14 † *I tell you, this man went down to his house justified rather than the other: for **every one that exalteth himself shall be abased; and he that humbleth himself shall be exalted.***

Legalism?

- Legalism is **a heart problem.**

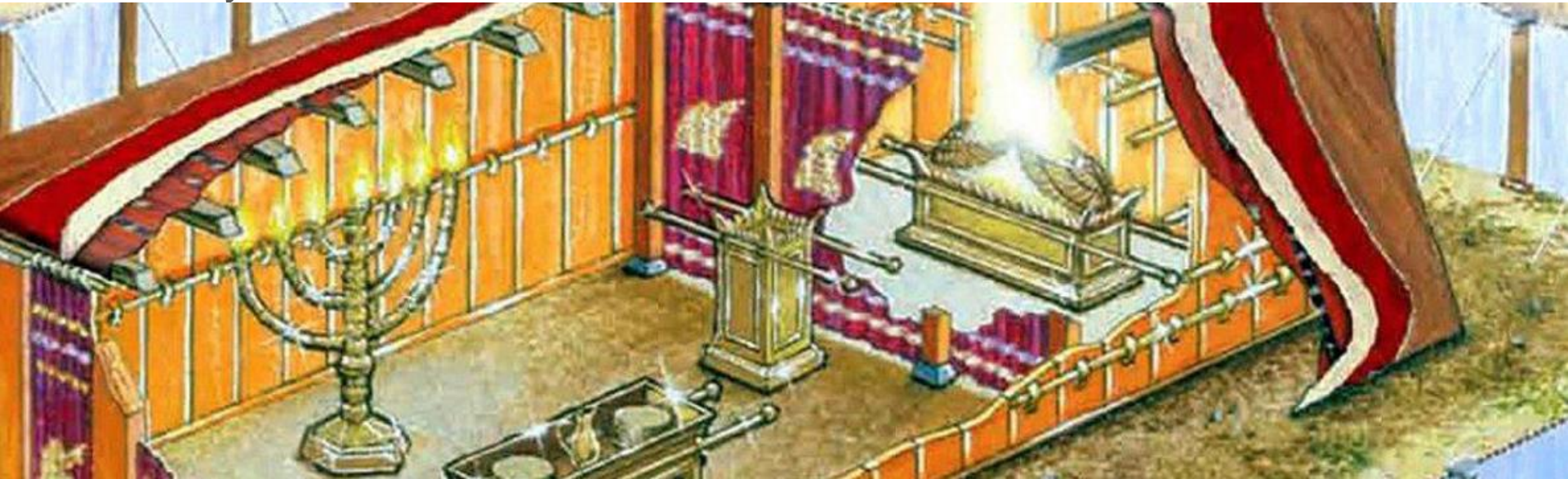

- » 2 † For there was a tabernacle made; the first, wherein was the candlestick, and the table, and the shewbread; which is called the sanctuary.



Hebrews 9:3-5

- » 3 And after the second veil, the tabernacle which is called the Holiest of all;
- » 4 Which had the golden censer, and the ark of the covenant overlaid round about with gold, wherein was the golden pot that had manna, and Aaron's rod that budded, and the tables of the covenant;
- » 5 And over it the cherubims of glory shadowing the mercyseat; of which we cannot now speak particularly.

HEBREWS 9:6-8
