It won't work. **But when you can really, with the sweetness from your heart, forgive every man, hold your peace, let it be gone, see, then it'll vulcanize. You can add that to your faith.**

The Impact of Vulcanization on Rubber

Unlike with thermoplastic chemical processes, the effects of vulcanization are permanent. After a rubber object or material has been vulcanized, **it can't be reversed.**
