1 Corinthians 4:1-4 (ESV)

1. This is how one should regard us, as servants of Christ and stewards of the mysteries of God.
2. Moreover, it is required of stewards that they be found faithful.
3. But with me it is a very small thing that I should be judged by you or by any human court. In fact, I do not even judge myself.
4. For I am not aware of anything against myself, but I am not thereby acquitted. **It is the Lord who judges me.**
5. Therefore judge nothing before the time, until the Lord come, who both will bring to light the hidden things of darkness, and will make manifest the counsels of the hearts: and then shall every man have praise of God.

Judge Ourselves First

MATTHEW 7:1

» 1 † Judge not, that ye be not judged.

» 2 † For **with what judgment ye judge, ye shall be judged**: and with what measure ye mete, it shall be measured to you again.

» 3 † And why beholdest thou the mote that is in thy brother's eye, but considerest not the beam that is in thine own eye?

» 4 † Or how wilt thou say to thy brother, Let me pull out the mote out of thine eye; and, behold, a beam is in thine own eye?

» 5 † **Thou hypocrite, first cast out the beam out of thine own eye; and then shalt thou see clearly to cast out** the mote out of thy brother's eye.

Unrealistic Expectations are Premeditated Resentment

- When we hold **rigid and unrealistic expectations** of others or situations, we set ourselves up for disappointment and resentment when those expectations are not met.
- It is natural to have certain expectations in life. We should approach them with **flexibility, understanding, and grace.**

Unrealistic Expectations are Premeditated Resentment

Constant praise and admiration

- Expecting that everyone should always praise and admire you (or your child) can be unrealistic.
- It's important to experience constructive feedback and learn how to handle both positive and negative evaluations.



Unrealistic Expectations are Premeditated Resentment

Special treatment or entitlement:

- The belief that you (or your child) should always receive preferential treatment or special privileges.
- Fairness and equality are essential values in society.



Unrealistic Expectations are Premeditated Resentment

Protection from all negative experiences:

- Wanting to be shielded (or to shield your child) from any form of discomfort, conflict, or disappointment is unrealistic.
- We need to be able to navigate challenging situations, learn problem-solving skills, and develop resilience to become well-rounded individuals.





Unrealistic Expectations are Premeditated Resentments

James 4:1-3 (NIV):

- "What causes fights and quarrels among you?
- **Don't they come from your desires** that battle within you?
- **You desire but do not have**, so you kill.
- You covet but you cannot get what you want, so you quarrel and fight.
- You do not have because you do not ask God.
- When you ask, you do not receive, because you ask with wrong motives,
- that you may spend what you get on your pleasures."



- And we know that a seed, when it falls in the right kind of ground; not upon rocks, with no root; nor in thorns and thistles, that would soon choke it out; but in good, rich, fertile faith. Every seed will bring forth of its kind.



- Now, now, that covenant lasted Israel on up till they made their final mistake.
- **Exodus 19**, hundreds of years later, when God had... Look what grace had provided: the unconditional covenant, not on any grounds at all, **but just on grace it was provided.**
- When they were taking their journey to the promised land, as God had promised back here--Abraham, his seed, would sojourn in a strange land for four hundred years under bondage, but would come out.
- Look, they was already out from under the bondage.
- **God, by grace, had provided them a prophet, a Pillar of Fire, a sacrificial lamb, a greatest revival they'd ever had; and they was standing on the banks dancing, beating tambourines, and having a real Pentecostal jubilee.**
- Everything, their enemies all killed behind them, and everything, **and yet they wanted something to argue about.**

Not by Works

Legalism:

- **the belief that salvation** or favor with God **can be earned** through strict adherence to religious rules, rituals, and moral codes. Believing that ones own efforts and good works can secure their salvation.
- This mindset of salvation through works **can lead to a self-righteous attitude** and **a judgmental outlook towards others** who do not adhere to the same set of rules.
- It **can also create a sense of pride in one's own achievements** and **a constant fear of falling short** or not measuring up to the required standard.

Ephesians 2:8-9:

"For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast."

Romans 3:28:

"Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by faith without the deeds of the law."

Romans 9:32-33:

"Wherefore? Because they sought it not by faith, but as it were by the works of the law. For they stumbled at that stumblingstone; As it is written, Behold, I lay in Sion a stumblingstone and rock of offence: and whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed."

I Corinthians 4:7

For who maketh thee to differ from another? and what hast thou that thou didst not receive? now if thou didst receive it, why dost thou glory, as if thou hadst not received it?


