« 105 ⁺ And this makes the professors get gray. But it--it's simple. Now, I'll read Matthew 28:19; you follow me. And some of you with Acts 2:38, have it ready. I'll begin unto the 18th verse; this is the closing chapter of Matthew.

See Him walking around through these church ages, the Christ, making Himself known to His people down through these Dark Ages, down through every age; while the church got formal and pulled out, and some went one way and some another, but that little minority of the church still held on, and Christ worked with them, confirming His Word; winds It right through.

« E-34 ⁺ All men cannot receive this. This is hid to the eyes of the world, and foolish to them. But those who are borned and elected to Eternal Life, believe it. We see the hour we're living. And all that God was He poured into Christ; and all Christ was He poured into the church. So the church has the power that Christ had. Christ had the power that God had.
