REVELATION 1:1-3

- » 1 † ¶ The Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave unto him, to shew unto his servants things which must shortly come to pass; and he sent and signified it by his angel unto his servant John:
- » 2 † Who bare record of the word of God, and of the testimony of Jesus Christ, and of all things that he saw.
- » 3 † ¶ Blessed is he that readeth, and they that hear the words of this prophecy, and keep those things which are written therein: for the time is at hand.

I PETER 1:9-13

- » 9 † Receiving the end of your faith, even the salvation of your souls.
- * 10 † ¶ Of which salvation the prophets have enquired and searched diligently, who prophesied of the grace that should come unto you:
- » 11 † Searching what, or what manner of time the Spirit of Christ which was in them did signify, when it testified beforehand the sufferings of Christ, and the glory that should follow.
- » 12 † Unto whom it was revealed, that not unto themselves, but unto us they did minister the things, which are now reported unto you by them that have preached the gospel unto you with the Holy Ghost sent down from heaven; which things the angels desire to look into.

1) 61-0611 REVELATION.CHAPTER.FIVE.1

« 92 † Now, we turn quickly, 'cause I know there's a baptismal service. What is this seven-sealed Book? Oh, what a great thing! Did you notice how it says here, "It was seven seals on the back of the Book"? It's something... Oh, may God help us now and give us courage, and maybe sooner or later I can get it to you. Look, this is not written in the Word, it's sealed on the back of the Word. The Book was sealed by these seven seals. The whole mystery of the Book is sealed up in these seven seals. This is one of the most greatest chapters in the whole Book of the Revelation. Look:

And I saw in the right hand of him that sat upon the throne a book written within and... written within (Inside's written, that's what we're reading this morning.) and... the backside, sealed with seven seals. Outside the Bible, what the Bible doesn't even say, it's sealed in here with seven seals: the mysteries of God.

2) 63-0318 THE.FIRST.SEAL

« 131 † Now, a trumpet always denotes war or otherwise political disturbance: the trumpet does, a political disturbance, and that causes war. When you go to get messing in politics, you get them all messed up, like we got it now, look out, war is at hand.

But, see, the kingdom still belongs to Satan. He's still got this part in his hand because why? It is redeemed by Christ, but He's doing the part of the Kinsman Redeemer taking His subjects, until the last one name is put on that Book, has already received it and been sealed away. Now, do you got it? Then He comes from His throne, His Father's throne, walks forward, takes the Book out of God's hand from the throne and claims His rights. The first thing He does is call for His Bride. Amen. Then what does He take? He takes His opponent, Satan, and binds him, and casts him into the fire out there with all that followed him.

Now, remember, it wasn't Russia. No, the antichrist is a smooth fellow. Just watch how smooth he is. He's smart. Yes, sir. Just takes the Holy Spirit, only thing can outdo him.

REVELATION 5:1-5

- » 1 † ¶ And I saw in the right hand of him that sat on the throne a book written within and on the backside, sealed with seven seals.
- » 2 † And I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice, Who is worthy to open the book, and to loose the seals thereof?
- » 3 † And no man in heaven, nor in earth, neither under the earth, was able to open the book, neither to look thereon.
- » 4 † And I wept much, because no man was found worthy to open and to read the book, neither to look thereon.
- » 5 † And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: behold, the Lion of the tribe of Juda, the Root of David, hath prevailed to open the book, and to loose the seven seals thereof.

3) 60-1209 THE.SARDISEAN.CHURCH.AGE

« 73 † Now let's take the 1st verse:.

...unto the angel of the church of Sardis write; These things saith he that has... seven Spirits of God, and the seven stars; I know thy work, that thou has a name that thou livest, and art dead.

Now the salute. Now, the seven Spirits are... "The seven Spirits and the seven stars." The Spirits was the angels that went to the stars which were messengers. "Seven Spirits," seven different times the Holy Spirit would anoint a messenger, which was a star in his day. A--a Spirit is Eternal, and the star that was made for a purpose to reflect Light in the dark of these church ages where candles and stars are representing. The angel, the Spirit, was the one that went to the star and reflected the Light of the Holy Spirit through this star to that church age. That, you might know... wonder who the seven Spirits are. It's the seven messengers of the seven church ages. See? Now, and each time that the star came in on the scene, the Holy Spirit came down and anointed that star and kept it just exactly like the first one was.

4) 61-0618 REVELATION.CHAPTER.FIVE.2

« 204 † Seven seals, seven Spirits, seven angels, seven horns, and seven churches. See, seven sevens, there's five sevens, which, seven is "perfection," five is "grace," God's grace to His Seven Church Ages. His seven messenger men, His seven Spirits of God, the seven planned seals of redemption (we're in right now), the seven horns means seven "ages."

Cause, a horn means a "kingdom." You remember the crown come upon the beast (horn) in Daniel, and so forth? See, it means a kingdom, or "seven ages." And, remember, Jesus said, "Some fell asleep in the first watch, one age; another one in the next watch, the next age; next; and the next; plumb on to the seventh watch. And in the seventh watch the Bridegroom come, and then all of them awakened." Remember that?

So it's seven "ages" was the seven horns, and seven churches, or the "seven ti-... dispensations of the body of believers." Oh, It's just as perfect as it can be. Jeremiah... My, "the Book," "ages," how it was redeemed! How... [Blank.spot.on.tape--Ed.]... right here.

« 231 † Seven horns was the seven churches (See?), the Seven Church Ages, because that was the Lamb's protection. What He protected His rights with on earth was a God-sent group of people that's protected. See, the horn on the Lamb...

Seven eyes are the seven messengers of the Seven Church Ages: seven eyes, seven seers.

« 236 † Now, let's turn over to Zechariah 4:10--4:10. Listen.

... who has despised the day of small things?... (God in simplicity. See?)... for they shall rejoice, and... see the plummet in the hands of Zerubbabel with whose--with those seven; these are the eyes of the LORD, which run to and fro through the whole earth.

The seven eyes--eyes mean seeing. Seeing means prophets, seers. This Lamb had seven horns, and on each horn had an eye: seven eyes.

What is it? Christ and His Bride. Seven Church Ages, out of there was seven prophets that went forth, seven seers, eyes. So the last one must be a seer. All right.

4 194 † John hadn't noticed this Lamb before, you know here. He hadn't been mentioned before. Nowhere had it been mentioned. It come from the Father's throne where He had been seated since He had been slain and raised again. He raised up and set on the right hand of God, ever living to make intercessions. Amen. Raised there today as an Intercessor with His own Blood to make intercession upon the ignorance of the people. Now, oh, that's the One I'm depending on. He still was covered with bleach, the bleach of the forgiveness of sin.

- « 52 † Then we find, after His death, burial, and resurrection, He came on the Day of Pentecost, as Son of God; God, the Spirit, in the form, Holy Ghost. What was He doing? He was changing Himself, making Himself known to His people in a different form. Like, the Holy Spirit, which is God, He came to deal through the church ages, as Son of God, the Holy Spirit.

« 180 † Now, if you ever notice, watch these church ages; then we'll close. And then in the morning we're going to pick up these other things. Watch. In the... Under the--the golden candlesticks of the Jewish tabernacle in the inside, of the shewbread and so forth, there was seven golden candlesticks. All of you know that. See? There's seven church ages. That speaks of seven church ages alike.

Now if you notice in Revelations 1, we find Jesus standing in the seven church ages, the seven golden candlesticks, when he turned and saw One like the Son of man standing clothed with a... How it was, it was a Bride standing in the candlesticks drawed out.

Now, in the Old Testament, they would take these, this one candle and light it, take the other candle and light off of that one, light off of that one, one off the other one like that, till they made the entire seven candlesticks.

Revelation 1:12,

"And I turned to see the voice that spake with me. And being turned, I saw seven golden candlesticks."

John does not say that he turned to see the one whose voice he heard, but he turned to see the voice. Oh, I like that. He turned to see the voice. The voice and the person are one and the same. Jesus is the WORD.
